

The Department of the Army will comply, whenever possible, with all feasible wishes of the next of kin in the final disposition of the remains of those members of the Armed Forces who made the supreme sacrifice.

You are advised that if the town of Chiomonte, Susu, Previdence Torcino, Italy, is your Homeland or the Homeland of your son, and it is your desire that his remains be returned there for final burial in a private cemetery, we will direct that the remains be removed from their present grave in the United States Military Limey, France, and transported, at Government expense, to whatever addresses you may designate. Disinterment will be made only at the time scheduled for the exhumation of this demetery. The Government will assist in obtaining medical clearance and reinterment authority. However, all costs and arrangements for burial and grave maintenance in the private cemetery desired, and funeral services will be your responsibility. Additionally, you will be required to release the United States Government from all responsibility for future care and maintenance of the grave and future return of the remains to the United States.

If the town of Chiomonte, Susu, Providence Wordino, Italy, is not your Homeland or that of your son and you desire that his remains be returned there for final interment, the remains may be delivered to you, or your designated representative authorized to receive the remains, at the United States Military Cemetery Limey, France, at the time scheduled for the exhumation of this cemetery.

The Department of the Army is not authorized to transport the remains to any location other than the Homeland of either the decedent or the next of kin. Terefore, you will be responsible for the entire costs and all necessary arrangements for the transportation of the remains from the presently occupied military cemetery to the private cemetery desired. As has been stated, you will be required to release the United States Government



The people of the United States, through the Congress have authorized the disinterment and final burial of the heroic dead of World War II. The Quartermaster General of the Army has been entrusted with this sacred responsibility to the honored dead.
