Cemetery, where German records indicate subject casualties were interred, on 7 August 1947, and twenty eight (28) remains were recovered Sixteen (16) of this total were identified by identification tags

b Records of the British 56th Graves Concentration Unit reveal that the British evacuated forty seven (47) deceased from the cemetery, and indicate that these casualties were identified as British personnel

c Attempts to associate the remaining unresolved unknowns recovered from the area, with the subject casualties, have been negative, due to negative comparison of identification data

## NARRATIVE OF DISINTERMENT

NEUBURXDORF, GERMANY (N 52/B- 83, 1/250,000)

7 - 8th August Disinterred in the community cemetery (Prisoner-of-War Section) of Neuburxdorf, Sachsen Province The remains of twenty-eight deceased were disinterred

The graves were located as shown on the attached sketch We could not take the graves in order in the disinterring as it would have caused too many cave-ins It was found that the basic documents listing the deceased by name, Stalag serial number, date of death, and grave number proved to be one hundred percent accurate Of the total exhumations from the cemetery, sixteen were identified by dog-tags, every name agreeing with the cemetery records as to the number of the grave Graves number 580, 582, 586, 620, 618 had no bodies in them The boxes were still there but the German laborers stated that the British Team which had been there before us had disinterred the bodies in those graves We made sure there were no remains in these graves or in the boxes which were in the graves by a very thorough examination of them all The tops of the coffins had been smashed in and each of the five showed evidence of having contained bodies In one, some hair still remained, We raised the coffins and dug under them without finding any trace of the bodies

Although we had nothing in our records on graves 583 and 590, the cemetery records showed that Americans were buried in both graves According to the cemetery records, grave 583 had an unknown American and grave 590 an American named Frank Gregory (Note: AGRC Cas Lists contain no person by that name).

All of the remains were in fair condition with the exception of that in grave 622 (Victor Petty) which was not buried in a box, and grave 593 (Lawrence Denson) which was under water

NARRATIVE OF INVESTIGATION  
Zittau, Germany (O 51/F 97, 1:250 000)

In accordance with instructions from Hq Berlin Det and report in attached basic documents the undersigned together with combined search and disinterment team # 1 and Russian Escort Officer Lt ZACHAROV arrived in ZITTAU, Germany, on 26 May 1948 at 1125 hrs to investigate

The following people were contacted; The Oberbürgermeister, the Landrat, the Police and Dr From POW hospital and the cemetery Superintendent. The records of each of these officers were examined, (see attached statements).

None of the people contacted had any knowledge of the death or burial of any American soldier in this town. The Dr who had charge of care of soldiers during the war said that POW patients were taken to ELSTERHORST to a military hospital, and that the only allied patients ever treated here were two French Officers who were transferred to Plauen/Saxony.

A search of all records proved negative

It is concluded that report in basic communication as pertaining to ZITTAU was false

On 7-8 August 1947 the 95th Quartermaster Battalion exhumed and recovered twenty-eight (28) remains, twenty-one (21) of which have been identified, the remainder are considered unidentifiable. During operations at the Neuburxdorf POW Cemetery grave sites 580 (ROHRBORN) 582 (NICKEL) and 586 (NEUMAN) were found vacant. According to the German laborers employed advised that the British Graves Concentration Unit removed the above mentioned remains on 20 June 1947. The 56th British Graves Concentration Unit was approached regarding the above mentioned empty graves. Their records reflected the recovery of forty-seven (47) identified British and Commonwealth decedents, none, however, from the graves cited above.

### III FINDINGS

On 17 December 1955, accompanied by Soviet Major Serganov and Sr Lieut Anthol, the undersigned proceeded to Neuburxdorf in an attempt to recover the remains of the above mentioned decedents.

According to the present Buergermeister Neumann and the former Buergermeister Kraus, the interment of Prisoner of War deceased was conducted entirely by the personal of Stalag IVb. A list of deceased, listing the grave number, decedent's Name, Nationality, Date of Death and Birth, Rank, Profession and Stalag number was periodically sent to the City Registrar Office, plot and row was not indicated. The register lists 720 individual grave, the two mass graves consisting of approximately 1500 and 200 Soviet deceased are not registered.

According to Mr Kraus two plots were used for the interment of Prisoners of War the front right plot was used primarily for French, Italian, Yugoslav and Polish deceased, the rear left plot for American, British, Belgian, Dutch and later, Polish and Soviet deceased. One series of grave numbers were utilized, regardless of nationality, therefore, grave numbers in the back plot were not in sequence.

Unfortunately it is not known to the Town Administration of Neuburxdorf which graves were actually exhumed by the individual disinterring units appearing at the cemetery. No disinterment reports were received from those teams with the exception of the Danish disinterring unit.

Accompanied by Mr Kraus and Neumann we visited the cemetery. The section known as the French - Italian plot was with the exception of eighteen (18) Italian, Yugoslav graves, have been completely exhumed. The rear left plot used for the interment of American, British, and others have been completely abandoned and is now overgrown with weeds. The existence of grave rows could only be ascertained through the presence of sunken grave sites. A survey of the complete area indicated that six (6) rows of approximately twenty-two (22) graves per row had, at one time existed.

In that it could not be determined what rows contained the grave sites of this missing American deceased it was decided that all six (6) rows be excavated. A trench approximately 120 meters in width was dug thru the six rows to be certain that no close interments took place.

Excavation began on 19 December with row 1. No remains were found. However, this row contained remnants of coffins commonly used for POW interments.

In row 2, grave space 5, remains of a male, approximately 36-38 years of age was found. Teeth were in extremely poor condition, no association could be made. No further remains located in row 2.

On the 19th of December excavation of row 6 was undertaken with the following results:

- Graves 1 thru 6 - Empty caskets
- Graves 7 and 8 - Caskets containing numerous amputated portions of upper and lower extremities
- Grave 9 - Casket containing remains of German Wehrmacht soldier

Grave 9 evidently was the last interment in this row as undisturbed soil was found beyond this grave.

Row 5 was next excavated with the following results:

Grave spaces 1, 2, 6, 7, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 17 and 19 contained casketed remains. Due to the extremely poor condition of teeth, and other physical characteristics, no association with subject decedents was possible.

On December 20th, row 4 was excavated with the following results:

Remains were located in grave spaces 2, 3, 4, 5, 12 and 13.

On basis of physical characteristics and condition of teeth, remains could not be associated with subject decedents.

On the morning of December 21st, the final row designated row 3 was exhumed. Remains were found in grave spaces 18, 19 and 20. Remains interred in spaces 18 and 19 were rejected as possible American deceased. Remains interred in space 20 were accepted as decedent Pvt FRITZ ROHRBORN, 39 Oll 975 on the basis of favorable dental comparison. No further remains were found in the remaining two graves exhumed.

It was learned during the course of this investigation, from an inhabitant of Neuburxdorf, that during the winter of 1945-46, members of the Soviet Army were observed removing all crosses erected over graves in the American - British plot. The numbered grave markers were not removed, however he recalled a number of these stakes were broken off and were lying on the grave or in the vicinity of the graves. During the course of the numerous disinterments by various Allied disinterring units these stakes were at times covered by earth from exhumed graves or removed entirely to be replaced later after backfilling was completed. This statement is a possible explanation as to why grave markers were found by the 95th QM Battalion over empty graves (580 ROHRBORN, 639 NICKEL, 586 NEWMAN) and remains recovered from 639 (ROEDER) 661 (GRZYS) 664 (MOHR) cannot be associated with those particular decedents. Since the informant requested confidence, the undersigned, made no attempt to have his statement confirmed.

IV. CONCLUSION

On the basis of current findings it is assumed that the remains of American deceased reported interred in this specific cemetery were erroneously removed by unknown disinterring units and must be considered non-recoverable.

V. RECOMMENDATIONS

The recommendations concerning the individual casualties are as follows:

1. ADDISON, Lee Pvt, 37 506 615

Subject decedent confined to Stalag IVb, entered Reserve Hospital I Leipzig on 18 March 1945, died 21 March 1945, Reserve Hospital V Leipzig, cause of death, Ulcerose Enteritis, Peritonitis, autopsy performed 22 March 1945. No place of internment given, but assumed to be Leipzig, in that it is doubtful that the remains were returned to Puhlberg-Neuburzdorf 60 Kilometers eastwards, to Stalag IVb which were evacuating the Prisoners of War at the time in the face of the Soviet advance. Recommend that subject decedent be retained on the Deferred Search Agenda until such time when investigation can be conducted in Leipzig, Germany.

2. PATY, Victor, Pvt, 32 732 478

Subject decedent confined to Stalag IVb, died of a Brain Abscess on 29 March 1945 and was interred POW Cemetery Neuburzdorf, Grave 622 on 2 April 1945. Remains recovered from grave 622 were identified as Pfc WILLIE L. SCOTLAND, 14 182 482 who, according to the Grave Register, was interred in grave 605 on 9 February 1945. Unknown X-6346 (Neuvillo-en-Condros) recovered from grave 605, had evidence of a cranial autopsy. Comparison of dental charts indicates possible association with VICTOR PATY. Height of X-6346 is not favorable to PATY, however, height measurement of X-6346 is based on a radius, ulna and femur measurement. The tibia, humerus and fibula are missing. It is assumed that a possible transposition of remains may have taken place, and it is recommended that case of X-6346 be reviewed in attempt to associate remains with subject decedent.

3. GORDON, William H., Pvt, 35 739 221

Was confined to Stalag IVb, POW # 316211. Notice received from City Registrar's Office Zittau (051/897) Germany that a GORDON, William was interred in the Frauenfriedhof (Women's Cemetery) of Zittau on 26 March 1945. Address of next of kin given as Mrs Corrie Gordon, Grafton, W. Va. Recommend retention on Deferred Search Agenda under Map Sheet O-51 until

such time when investigation can be conducted at Bittau, Germany.

4. GRZYB, Andrew J., Pvt, 36 262 097

Subject decedent died of Heart Failure on 5 May 1945 while confined as POW # 316707 at Stalag IVb and was interred grave 661, Neuburxdorf POW cemetery. Remains disinterred from grave 661 by the 95th QI Battalion cannot be associated with subject decedent. Recommend that remains of subject decedent be declared non-recoverable, on basis of current investigation findings.

5. MILLINGHAM, Lloyd G., Sgt, 16 171 775

Subject decedent was confined to Stalag IVb as POW 3 316248 and was not returned to military control at the cessation of hostilities. No record of burial existing in Neuburxdorf. Recommend remains of subject decedent be declared non-recoverable on basis of current findings.

6. TRIN, Robert L., Pfc, 39 727 244

Subject decedent died of Malarial Fever on 7 May 1945 while confined as POW # 316249 at Stalag IVb and was interred in grave 664, Neuburxdorf POW cemetery.

Remains disinterred from grave 664 by the 95th QI Battalion cannot be associated with subject decedent. (X-6347)

Recommend on basis of current findings that remains of subject decedent be declared non-recoverable.

7. HESTON, Louis A., Pvt, 33 740 542

Subject decedent died of Diphtheria while confined to Stalag IVb on 20 January 1945, and interred in grave 586, Neuburxdorf POW cemetery.

Upon excavating grave 586 an empty coffin was found by the 95th QI disinterment unit.

The German laborer hired claimed the remains removed by the British 56th C.C.D. However, this organization upon being contacted claimed they had not removed remains from grave 586, and all recovered forty-eight (48) remains were identified as British personnel.

During current investigation no remains were located that could be associated with the subject decedent.

Recommend that remains of subject decedent be declared non-recoverable.

8. FILMST, Charles W., Pfc, 32 388 905

Subject decedent died of Diphtheria while confined to Stalag IVb on 14 January 1945 and was interred in grave 582, Neuburxdorf POW cemetery.

Upon excavating grave 582, an empty casket was found by the 95th QI disinterment unit.

The German labor hired claimed the remains were removed by the British 56th G.C.U., however, this organization upon be contacted claimed they had not removed the remains from grave 582, and all recovered remains were identified as those of British personnel.

During current investigation no remains were located that could be associated with the subject decedent.

Recommend that remains of decedent be declared non-recoverable.

9. HOBSON, Wilbur J., Pfc, 36 956 776

Subject decedent died of Fleuris on 26 April 1945 while confined as POW # 319151 at Stalag IVb and was interred in grave 639, Heuburxdorf P.O. cemetery.

Unknown X-5349 recovered from grave 639 cannot be associated with the subject decedent and have been declared unidentifiable.

Remains located during current investigation could not be associated with subject decedent.

Recommend that remains of subject decedent be declared non-recoverable.

10. SMITH, Louis M., Pfc, 36 204 517

Subject deceased was confined to Stalag IVb POW # 315140, and according to information listed on Form 371 place of death is shown as Leipzig, Germany date of death 12 April 1945.

No record of interment of subject decedent could be found at Heuburxdorf. remains located during current investigation could not be associated with decedent. Recommend that remains of the subject decedent be declared non-recoverable.

11. BRIDGEMAN, James D., T/Cgt, 20 401 576

Subject deceased according to fellow Prisoner of War T/Cgt J WILLIAMS B died during a forced march from Stalag VIIIa (Coerlitz 052/800) on 8 March 1945 place of death or interment is not given.

Remains located during current investigation could not be associated with subject decedent be declared non-recoverable.

1. Reference is made to Nonrecoverable Findings for Pvt Lee E Anderson, 37586615, and eleven (11) others and to AGO Memorandum, dated 7 July 1945, SUBJECT: Review and Determination of Status of Private First Class Elliott R Lund, 31373644, and the others who were prisoners of war.

2. Further reference is made to paragraph 1, AGO Memorandum concerning a list of "British and American Grave Numbers for 1941-45, Stalag IV B, Muhlberg/Elbe, Germany." A revised roster has been compiled reflecting burials as recorded on this list as well as disinterment of twenty-eight (28) American deceased from Stalag IV B, QM Cemetery Neuburxdorf by AGRS personnel on 7-8 August 1947 and is attached herewith. In regard to the photographs of the funeral service, available records in the Office of The Quartermaster General reflect receipt of same; four of these photographs are recorded for Pvt FATTY, Pvt. NEWMAN, Pfc. WICKEL and Pvt. ROHRBORN. On the reverse of each photograph is recorded the full name, ASN, POW number, emergency addressee, date of death and grave location

3. It will be noted that of the twenty-eight (28) American deceased recovered from the Neuburxdorf Cemetery, information furnished on twenty-two (22) identified remains (recorded by name, date of death and grave as interred in this cemetery by attached roster) was found to be 100% accurate. Examination of the Neuburxdorf roster further proved that the deceased were interred in chronological sequence by date of death.

4. According to paragraph 2, Narrative of Disinterment of Neuburxdorf Cemetery, German laborers advised that the British had disinterred remains from graves 580, 582, and 586 (recorded on subject roster as the burial location of Pvt. ROHRBORN, Pfc WICKEL and Pvt NEWMAN, respectively). The report further indicates that the British 56th Graves Concentration Unit was contacted and that examination of their files disclosed that "they had not had anything to do with the graves in question". Displaced Persons was also contacted and they advised that their disinterment teams had not been in Neuburxdorf as of 7-8 August 1947. In spite of these negative findings, the fact remains that graves 580, 582, and 586 had been opened; that the empty caskets were examined and evidence found by AGRS personnel proved that remains had been buried therein. (Note: British authorities reported recovery of forty-seven (47) deceased from this cemetery indicating identification established as British personnel; however, the attached roster only reflects the recorded interments of forty-four (44) British deceased.)

5. In view of the above findings, it is requested that information be furnished the Office of The Quartermaster General, if available, pertaining to the following

a. That the Imperial War Graves Commission be contacted for the following:

(1) Obtain a list of the 47 identified British deceased showing the date of death and the recorded grave location in Neuburxdorf Cemetery from which they were disinterred.

(2) That their records of World War II deceased be examined for a British casualty by the name of Frank Gregory. Subject roster records the interment in grave 590 as F. Gregory, born 2 December 1921, died 21 January 1945 of diphtheria; POW #75408/XII A; religious preference - Church of England; nationality - English. (Note: Unknown L-6359, USMC Neville, now classified as unidentifiable as an American casualty, was recovered from grave 590, and is listed on associated documents as BTB Frank Gregory.)

b. Request your detachment determine from available records whether interments in Neuburxdorf Cemetery were accomplished in graves other than those recorded by name as shown on attached roster.

c. If such burials were accomplished, that the names, dates of death and nationality of decedents disinterred and identified from these graves be furnished.

d. Whether graves adjacent to (immediate right and left) those recorded on roster as "AMERICAN" were opened by AGRS personnel during 7-8 August 1947

6. In the event the information requested cannot be obtained and/or is not available to your detachment, request the Office of The Quartermaster General be advised as to the feasibility of placing this case on current search agenda for the purpose of re-investigating Neuburxdorf.

7.
