In response to your request for service on April 2, 1949, we contacted our District of Columbia Chapter and are writing to relay to you the report received.



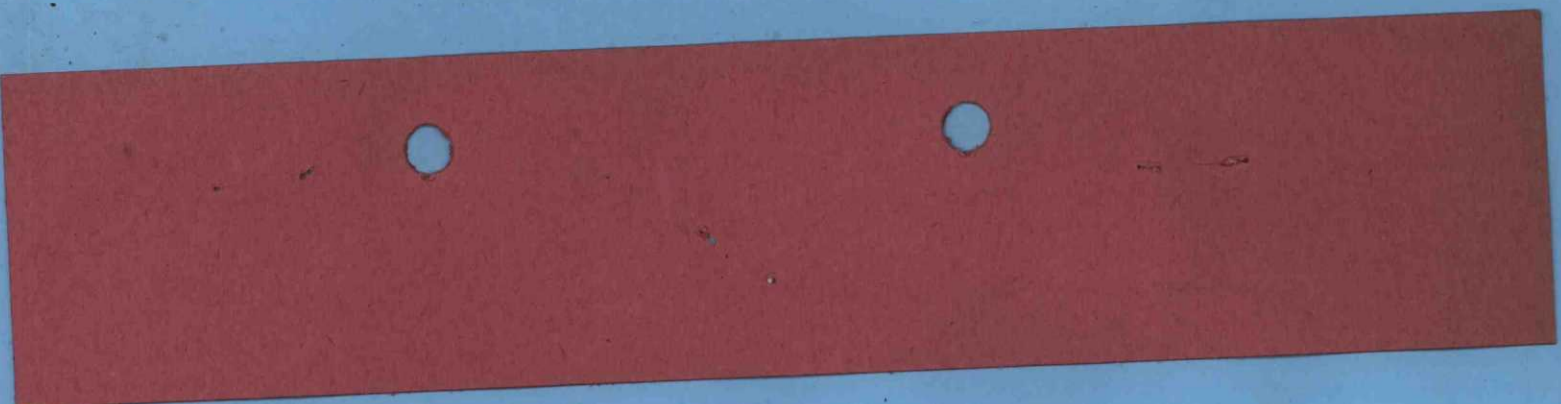


