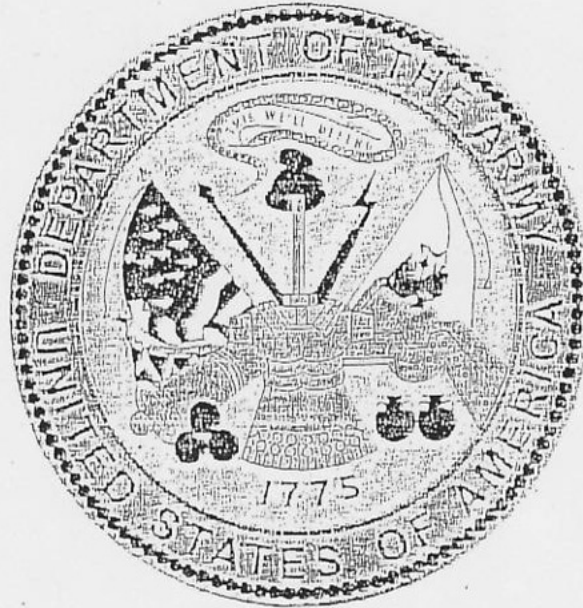

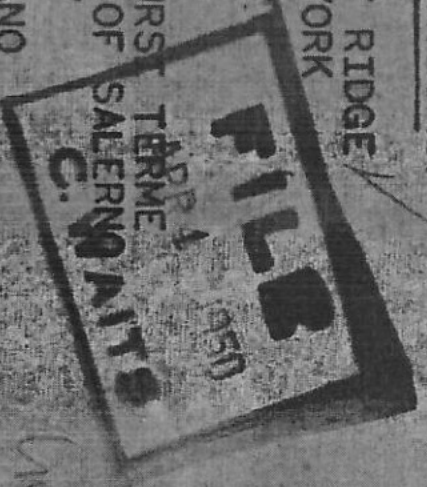

8. As the markers will be consigned to the American Consul in Italy, it is requested the Consul be furnished pertinent data concerning shipment to destination. The State Department, Washington, D. C., is notifying the Consul regarding re-imbursement of expenses incident to completion of shipment.

Reference is made to the "Letter of Inquiry - Disposition of Remains" sent to you several weeks ago requesting you to complete and mail the "Request for Disposition of Remains" form to this office in the case of the above named decedent.

Due to the magnitude of the Return of World War II Dead Program, it has been necessary to set up definite schedules of operations by overseas cemetery. Therefore, it is highly important that the wishes of the next of kin be obtained prior to the closing of operations in specific cemeteries. In those cases where disposition is not obtained from Next of Kin within a reasonable time, there is no alternative except to inter the remains in a permanent overseas U. S. Military Cemetery.

In order that proper disposition of the remains may be made without undue delay, it is requested that the form you received, "Request for Disposition of Remains", be completed and returned to this office as soon as possible. If the form is not returned or a reply from you is not received within fifteen days from date of this letter, this office will assume that you desire that the remains be interred in a permanent overseas U. S. Military Cemetery.

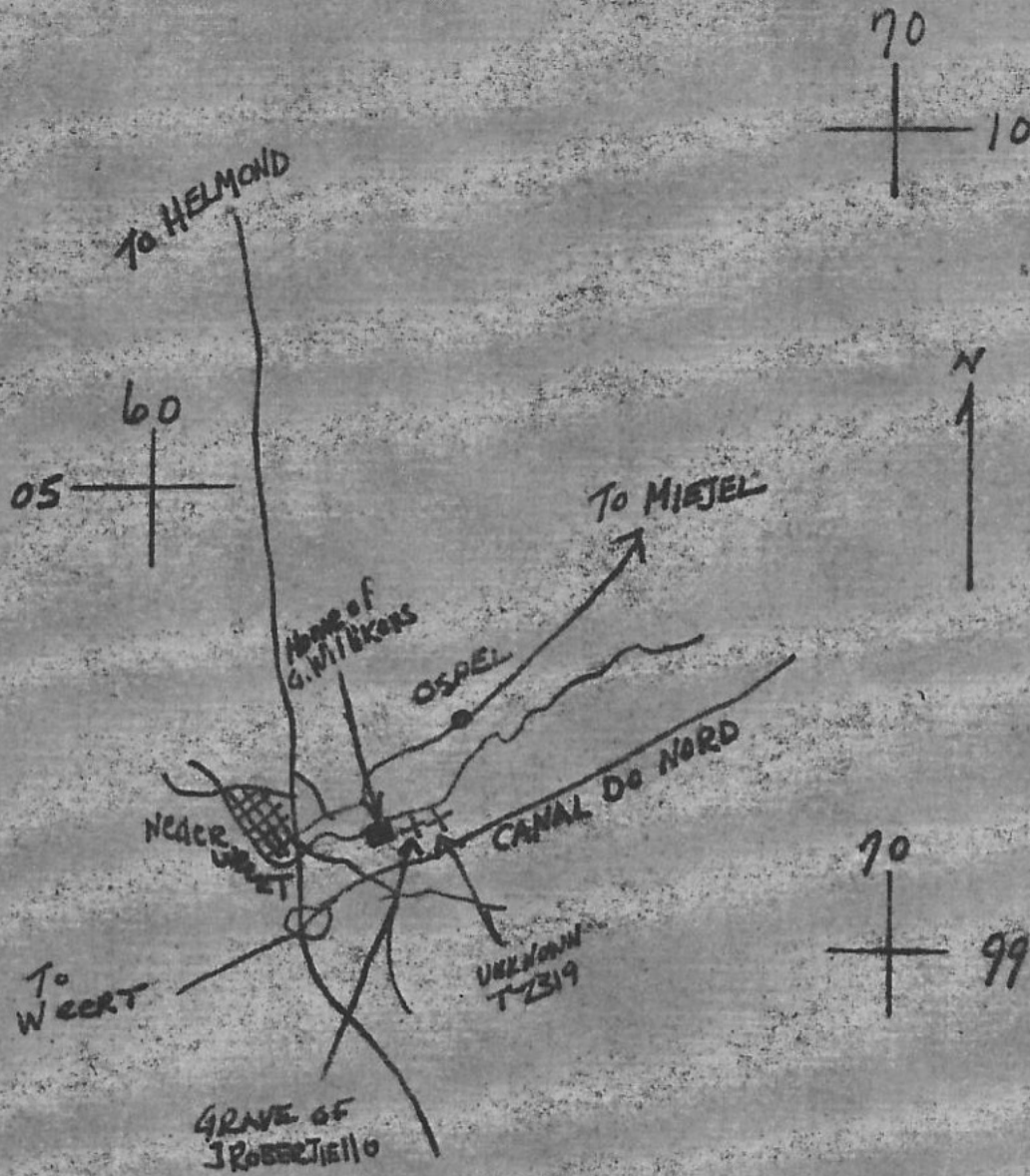



