**1. George F. Shirts** – Nose Gun <u>509BS</u>, <u>351BG</u>, 22 Jan 45, 17136758, McDaniel Cem; Cameron, Missouri

- 2. Harry M. Paxton -<u>B/23 AIB</u>, 8 Oct 44, 37 736 701, Margraten
- 3. James D. Baldwin <u>C/38 AIB</u>, 4 Oct 44, 33 529 694, Margraten (was originally <u>T-1902</u>)
- **4. John M. Dysinger, Jr**. <u>C/48 AIB</u>, 5 Oct 44, 33 511 339, USA cemetery not yet known
- 5. Bennie J. Kuykendall: <u>AT?/C/48 AIB</u>, 4 Oct 44, 38516376, Liberty Cem; Stamps, Arkansas
- 6. S/Sgt Joseph J. Ferrari <u>C/48 AIB</u>, 3 Oct 1944 (official 5 Oct), Margraten (<u>T-1901</u>, later <u>X-1212</u>)
- 7. Egbert L. Burt: C/48 AIB, 5 Oct 44, 38399612, Oak Park Cem; Chandler, Oklahoma

**8.** 1<sup>st</sup> Lt. William R. Grounds – Pilot <u>389FS</u>, <u>366FG</u>, 0-809129, USA cemetery not yet known

**9. DOGALI./DOGALL** – not on WWII Registry nor on 7AD list with either spelling – probably airman **10. Myer Epstein**: <u>A/38 AIB</u>, 5 Oct 44, 33 749 676, Arlington National Cem

**11.** T-1741 – Unknown to British and given to American Graves Registration for recovery Thanks to Joost Evertsen for the identifications of #1 and #6.
