Unknown X-92 Blosville, France was recovered from the D-Day beach near Cellesville sur Mer, (Manche) France. Date of death as indicated above is determined as 6 June 1944. Cause of death is unknown, however probably small arms fire or drowning as indicated by the skeletal chart.

This unknown was formerly erroneously identified, since been redesignated X-92.

A further attempt has been made to associate X-92 with casualties on or about D-Day but this has proven negative.

In view of the above this case is considered as UNIDENTIFIABLE.

1. Reference is made to Corrected Report of Burial for Godfray, Leonard C., Major, O-20344 (previously X-92), Plot T, Row 7, Grave 130, USMC Bloisville, France.

2. Due to the fact that identification is based solely on missing teeth of X-92 being in agreement with those shown missing on dental records for Major Godfray, this Office cannot approve the identification as established by your headquarters. It is therefore requested that the remains be redesignated Unknown X-92.


3. Information, contained in attached photostatic copies of letters from the organization Chaplain and other officers, reveals that Major Godfray was buried in St. Laurent. Two other deceased from the same organization, who are mentioned in these letters, were buried in St. Laurent; namely, Lt. Colonel John H. Mathews, O-018626 and Captain Alan R. Morehouse, O-351409.

4. In view of the information being forwarded, it is recommended that an investigation of Unknowns interred in St. Laurent be conducted for an association with Major Godfray and this Office notified of the results.

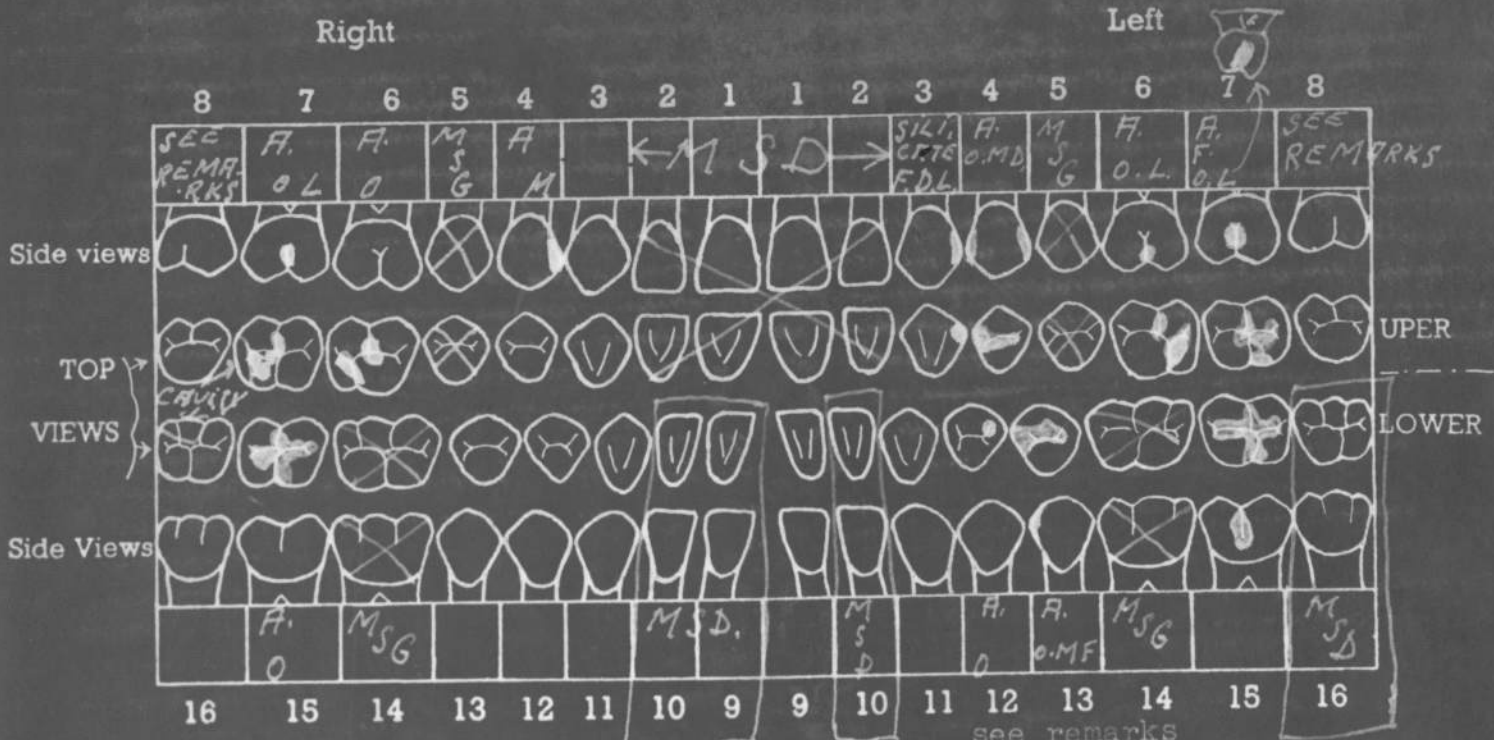
