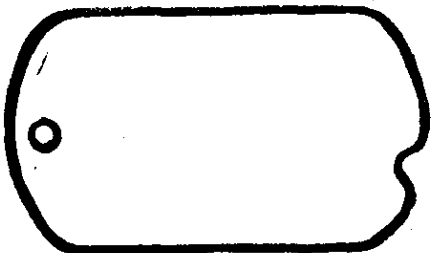

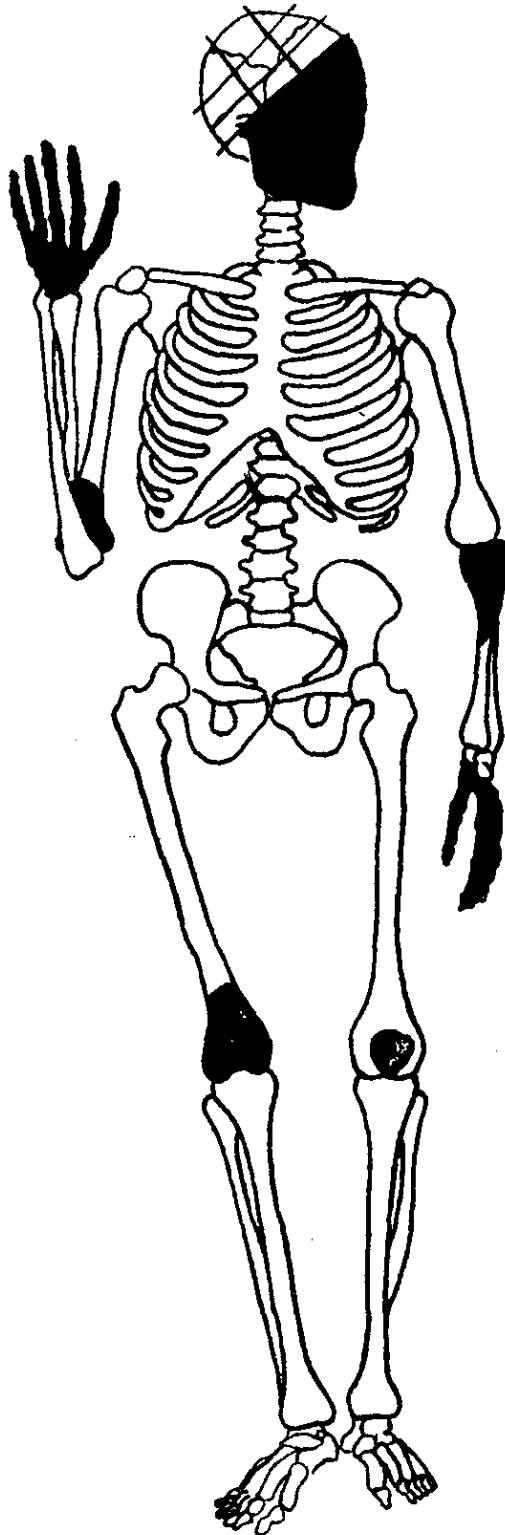
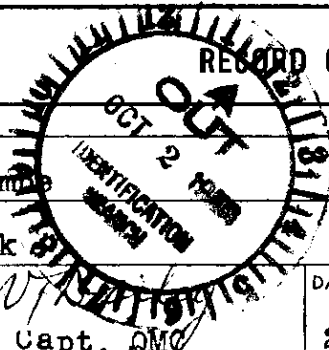


CHART "A"
