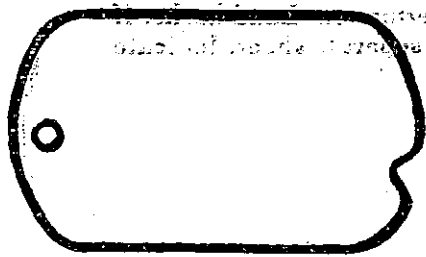

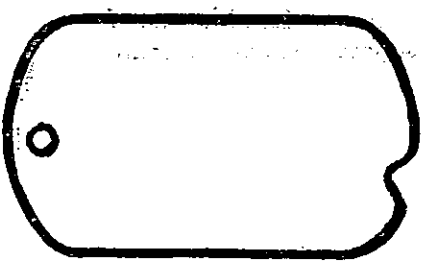

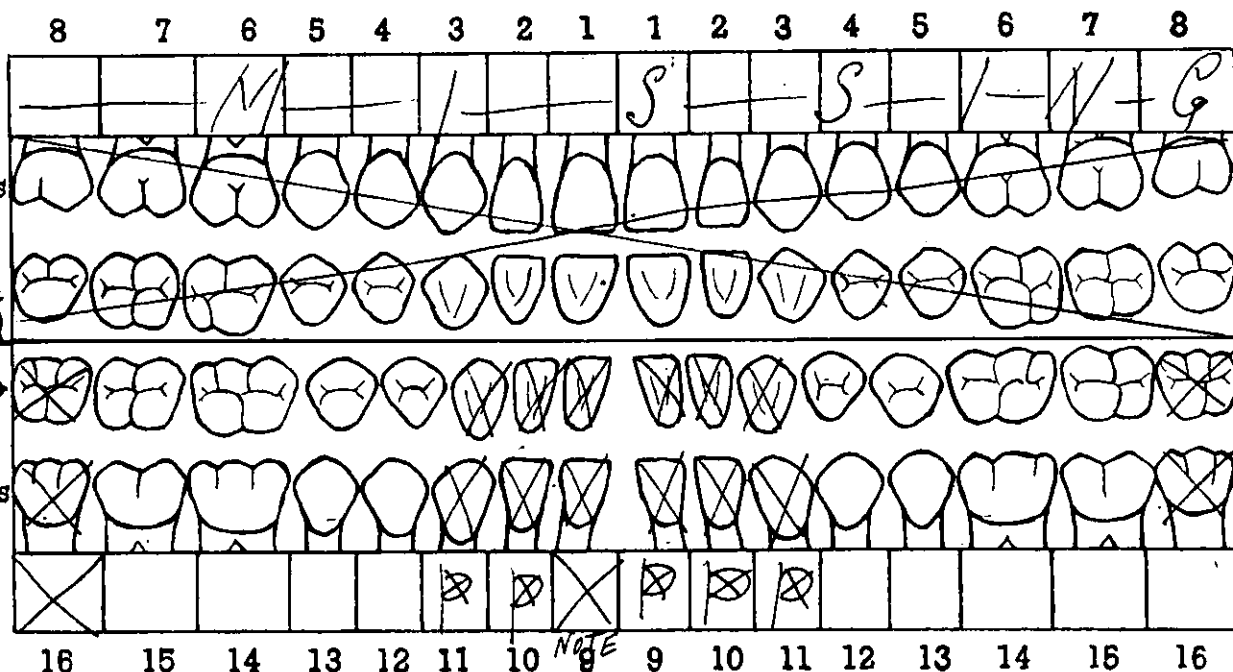

This dental chart is very important and should be filled in with great care. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws, the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspid (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: Lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridge work, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found. ADDITIONAL SPACE FOR FURTHER REMARKS

REMARKS: Root pocket of L-9 has filled in lingually the space of R-9 which was extracted. Position of this root pocket L-9, indicates the alignment of the incisors of the mandible to be irregular.

Unusually deep occlusal surfaces on the molars.

Condition of the restorative bone in the mandible indicates that R-16 and L-16 were not current extractions.

Curvature of the mandible -- Normal.

Color of teeth -- Ivory
