



The remains now designated Unknown X-1093 (USMC Saint Avold) were recovered from the vicinity of Heppenheim, Germany. These remains were originally thought to be those of S/Sgt Earl W. WATSON, 33317700 but the fingerprints on Report of Burial do not correspond with those of S/Sgt Watson. Fingerprints were also compared against casualties known to have been interred in cemetery from which these remains were recovered also without results. Several attempts have been made to identify this Unknown through the use of fingerprints without results. Tooth chart and physical characteristics of X-1093 have been compared against unresolved casualties in the area from which these remains were recovered also without results. In view of this these remains are being declared UNIDENTIFIABLE.
