

The remains now designated Unknown X-1096 (USMG Saint Avold) were recovered from the vicinity of Reppenheim, Germany. These remains were originally thought to be those of Pvt Paul E. ESTILL, Jr., 18148251 but the fingerprints on Report of Burial do not correspond with those of Pvt Estill. Fingerprints were also compared against casualties known to have been interred in commetery from which these remains were recovered also without results. Several attempts have been made to identify this Unknown through the use of fingerprints without results. Tooth chart and physical characteristics of X-1096 have been compared against unresolved casualties in the area from which these remains were recovered also without results.
