

- 1. Reference is made to separate Reports of Burial received in this headquarters for Pfc. Frederick L. DICKENSON, ASN 33091293 shown as buried in St Avold Cemetery, Plot XX, Row 6, Grave 62 as well as Plot Y, Row 4, Grave 41.
- 2. Inasmuch as the deceased buried in Plot Y, Row 4, Grave 41 was identified by Soldiers Individual Pay Record and other substantiating evidence, but buried without legs, it is believed that the remains buried in Plot XX, Row 6, Grave 62 may be the missing members as the remains were merely identified by the clothing mark "D-1293" marked on both shoes of the deceased.




