

On 12 December 1944, organizations which were assigned and attached to the 26th Infatry Division, of the III Corps, were occupying positions near the following points:


Elements of the 35th Infantry Division was able to advance under heavy artillery and small arms fire during this period. The 134th Infantry Regiment of the 35th took HABKIRCHEN, GERMANY and crossed the BLIF RIVER on 12 December 1944 and the 137th Inf (35th Div.) continued to mop up in SARREGUEMINES.

Zones of the 4th and 6th Armored Divisions and the 80th Infantry Divisions were near the Zones of the 26th and 35th Divisions.




