

- 2. A thorough investigation was conducted in the vicinity of Bennwihr to locate the remains of S/Sgt Vernon L. Bensley. The local mayor and other civilians who might have possessed knowledge of isolated graves were contacted, but no one could furnish this information. (See attached statement).
- 3. In the course of investigation, however, three American graves were discovered. Upon disinterment, the three remains were unidentified. One of the bodies had been removed from a burned-out tank, but the other two were found lying on top of the ground. These two were buried as follows:



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
