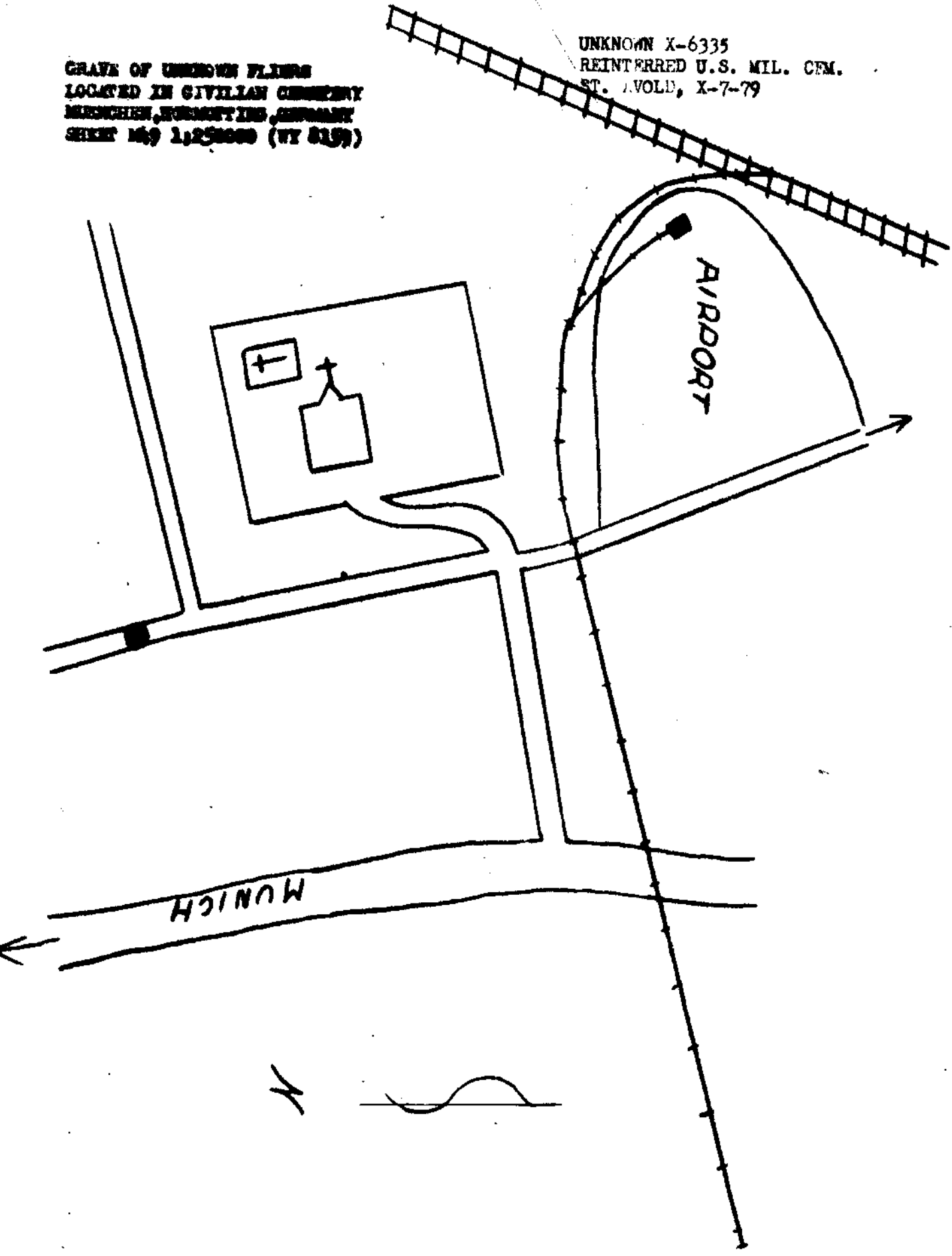

- 1) 4 graves of American soldiers are in our Area of Responsibility.

- 3) 3 graves, containing in total 89 men are in the cemetery of the community Oberschleissheim and 1 grave, containing 15 men, is located few meters from the cemetery.

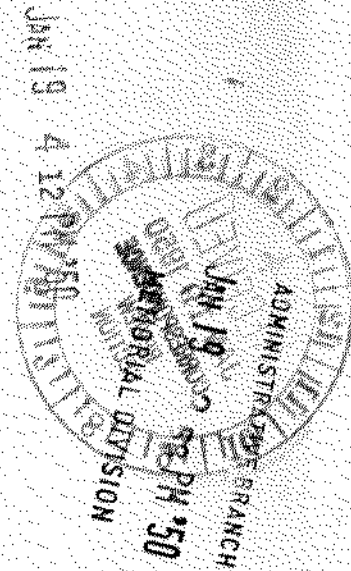

1. The remains of Unknown X-6335, USMC S⁺ Avoird, were recovered from the civilian cemetery at HOCHMUTTING, Germany, along with numerous other unknown deceased.

2. Thorough review of the case on Unknown X-6335 failed to establish an association with any one of the unresolved casualties within the Germany M-49 area. Since the tooth chart contained in this case indicates silicate fillings in R-6 and L-15, and the use of such material in filling molars is not standard practice in American dentistry, these teeth may be those of a non-American. This is substantiated by the fact that there are no clothing and equipment on the remains that indicate American nationality.

3. In view of the foregoing it is recommended that the remains of Unknown X-6335 be declared UNIDENTIFIABLE.
