

TRANSLATION CERTIFICATE

On the 3rd June 1944 two women(whoestname I do not know) came to me and told me that An American Soldier was laying on the curve of the main road dead. I phoned the American Med Cross and reported the death of the American Soldier. An American first Lt came to me and I took him to the place where the body was laying. He ordered me to burie the body immediately without casket or marking on the grave. He also ordered me not to search the body and not to take anything offthe body. As far as I know that body still has all the personal items on it. From the end of the ribs up was blown off diagnally across his body. The head and arms and other parts of the body we did not find. The exact cause of the death I do not know it was reported to me that he steped on a mine. The area was heavly mined at the time. This is all I know concerning the death of the Amer ican Soldier.


