

# Certificate of UNIDENTIFIABILITY

The remains of Unknown X-848 St.Avold, were recovered from the civilian cemetery at Munchweiler, Ger. (K-50). Date of death is estimated as 19 March, 1945. Subject remains were re-buried in USMC Bensheim, Germany. Report of Burial shows that Unknown X-848 was recovered from a burned out tank #3081652.

Subject remains were previously identified as the only recoverable remains of the last two (2) remaining casualty crew members of subject tank.

Subsequent re-investigation and reprocessing by CIP of the remains of Unknown X-848 showed that subject remains did not meet death by burning, contradictory to cause of death as shown on original ROB (3rd degree burns).




