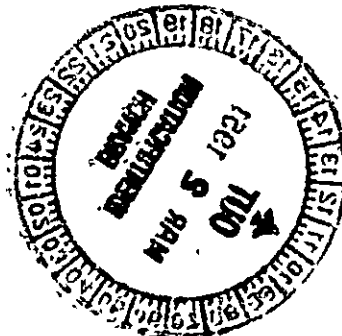
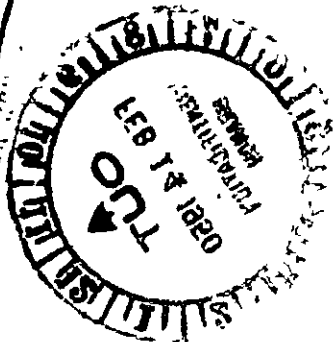

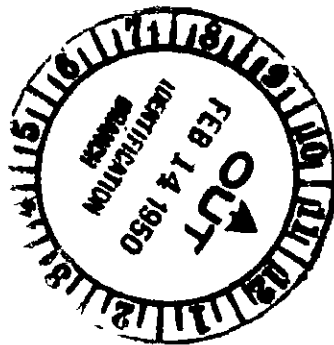

UNIDENTIFIABLE

Unknown X-260 was recovered from the Forest of Irsch, Germany. Date of death is unknown and cannot definitely be determined. There are no teeth present to aid in making an association with an unresolved casualty. Unknown X-260 was recovered from the same area as six other American casualties who have all been identified and who are all from different organizations thus making it impossible to associate Unknown X-260 with a certain organization. Markings "MLV and RDM" were found on canteen and canteen cover found with the remains of Unknown X-260, but no association can be made with these initials and an unresolved casualty, thus Unknown X-260 is being submitted as Unidentifiable due to lack of any positive identifying media.

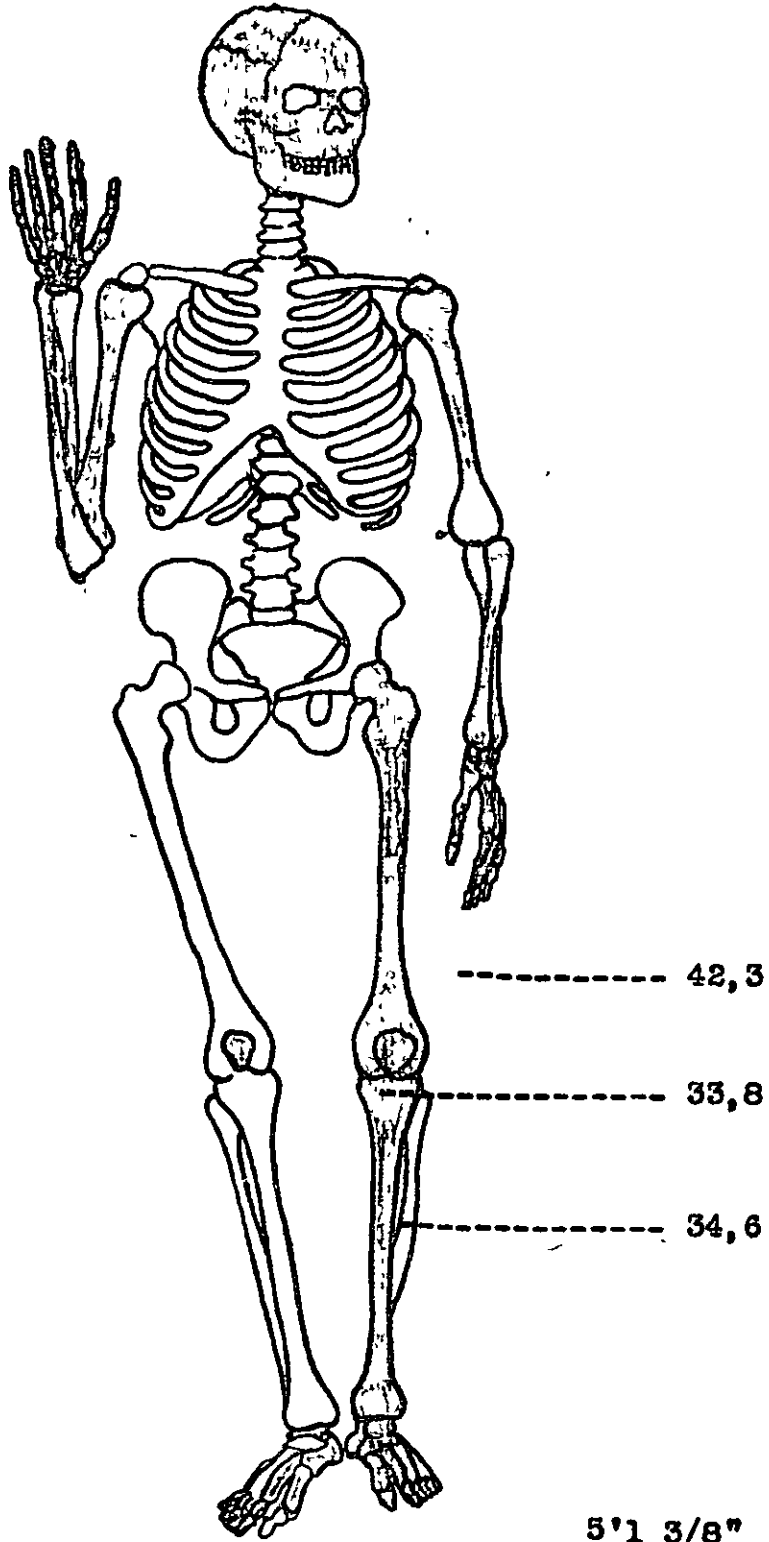

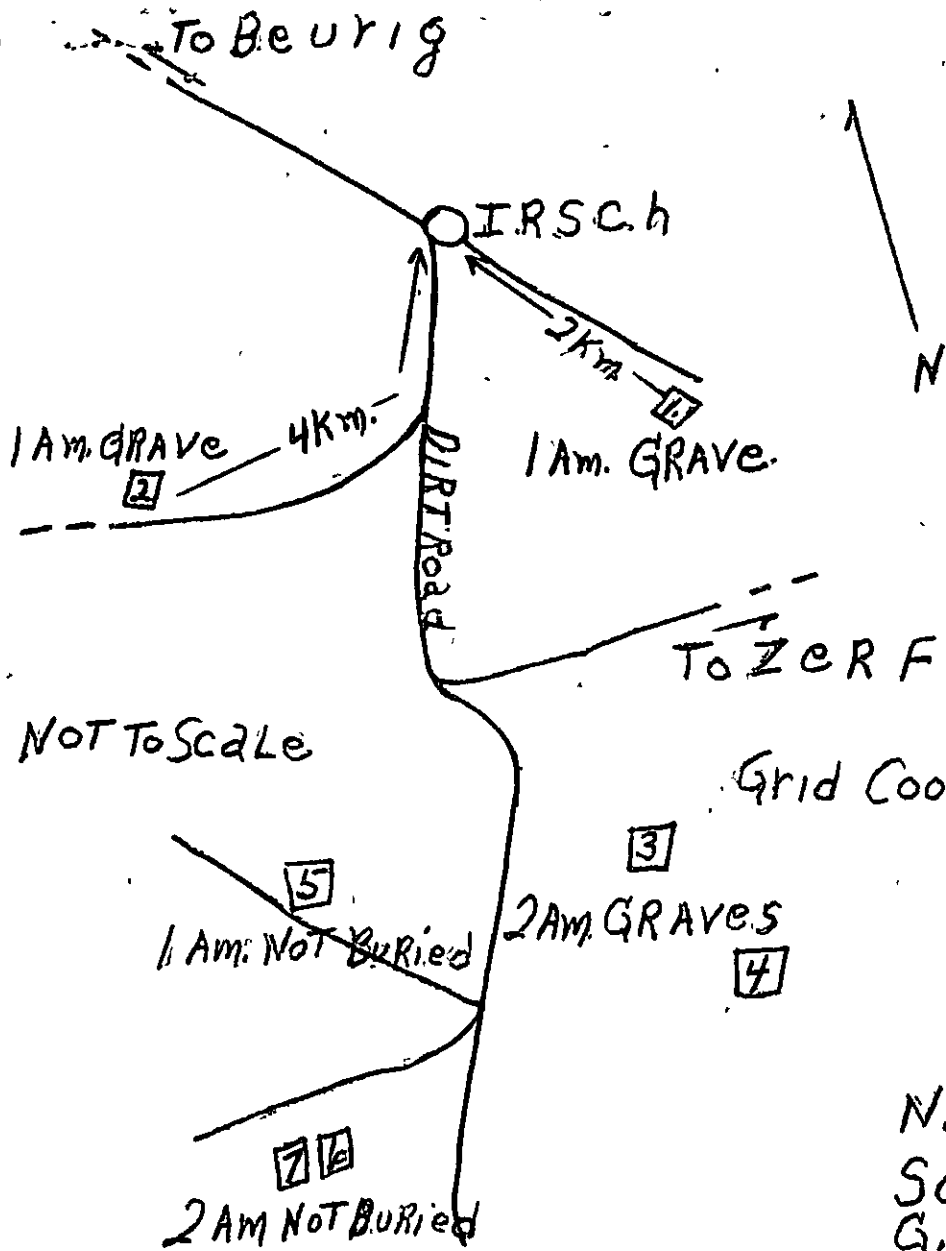
