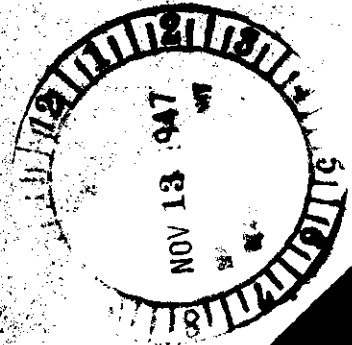

1. Reports of Burial for Unknown X-395 and X-396, USMC, Henri-Chapelle, Belgium, were forwarded to the office of The Quartermaster General by 1st Indorsement, Hq., AGRG, dated 18 March 1946, to a letter from Headquarters First United States Army. The Indorsement requested that the fingerprints of Pfc Vincent Burgo, ASN 36962129, be compared with the partial fingerprints of both X-395 and X-396.

2. From the reply, 2nd Indorsement, Hq, ASF, OQMG, dated 17 April 1946, it cannot be inferred that the fingerprints of X-395 were compared with those of Pfc Burgo. Since it is possible that X-395 is Pfc Burgo, it is requested that the comparison be made and this office informed of the results.
