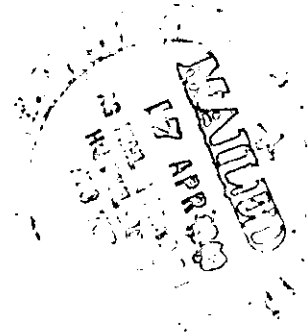
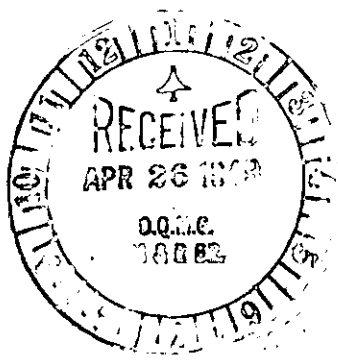

TO : Sector Commander, American Graves Registration Service,
PHILRYCOM, APO 707

1. Your attention is invited to inclosures.
2. There have been no remains interred in USAF Cemetery #5 plot 2; grave 68. It is believed that after the reports of interment were made up but before the remains were interred it was decided to fill some vacant graves and Unknown X-240 instead of being interred in Cemetery #5 was interred in Cemetery #1 as Unknown X-36 grave 442. The reasons for this assumption are.
 - a. Plot 2 in its entirety has been removed and examined for the possibility of X-240 being put by error into a casket with some other remains. This was found not to be the case.
 - b. Report of interment for Unknown X-36 states "Remains recovered from isolated burial Ali Island Aitape Area, New Guinea. Natives state this man was only American soldier killed in the Ali landing." Report of interment for Unknown X-240 has as his place of death Ali Island.

1. Attention is invited to basic communication and inclosures thereto.

2. In view of the fact that remains of Unknown X-240 of USAF Cemetery, Finschhafen #5, were not interred in Plot 2, Grave 68, of that cemetery (as originally intended) but, instead, were interred in USAF Cemetery, Finschhafen #1, as Unknown X-36, Grave 442, it is requested that:

(1) Permission be granted to revoke Report of Interment prepared for Unknown X-240.

(2) "Unknown X-240" of USAF Cemetery, Finschhafen #5, lose its identity as such.

(3) Permission be granted to change the original Identification Dental Chart prepared for Unknown X-240 (copy of which is attached as Inclosure #3) so as to indicate it is a Dental Chart for Unknown X-36. In this connection, a further comparison can be made with remains of Unknown X-36 if deemed necessary by your office.

(4) The designation of Unknown X-36, Grave 442, USAF Cemetery, Finschhafen #1, be officially recorded as the resting place of subject remains.

3. It is believed the statement contained in Paragraph 2, basic communication, reference the thorough examining of Plot 2 - in its entirety -, in addition to the facts that the Report of Interment on remains of Unknown X-240 states the place of death as Ali Island, and the Report of Interment on remains of Unknown X-36 states same "... were recovered from isolated burial Ali Island ... this man was only American soldier killed in the Ali landing", substantiates the above request.
