2. This organization was assigned to the 6th Army on 17 September 1944, and left Base F on 25 September 1944 for a secret destination. While en route from Base F, the Liberty Ship, Don Marquis, carrying this organization was rammed by the tanker "Missionary Ridge." Fire broke out immediately on deck between hatches No. 1 and No. 2. All organizational equipment, personal clothing and equipment, all company records, allied papers and personal effects of this organization which were stowed in hatches No. 1 and No. 2 and on deck were a total loss. This accident occurred on 26 September 1944, on or about 1820 hours in the general vicinity, seven miles north of Lou Island of the Admiralty Group. Survivors were picked up by the Australian Ships Hawkspray, Birdekin and Missionary Ridge and were taken to the Naval Base, Manus Island for quarters and hospitalization for the wounded. On the 27th we were moved to the Army Base of the First Cavalry Division on Los Negros Island.

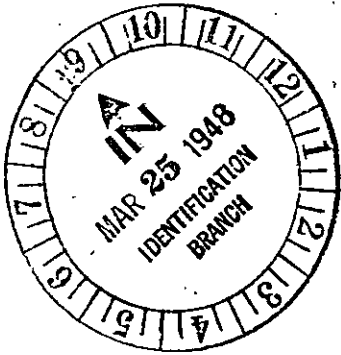


# SKELETAL CHART

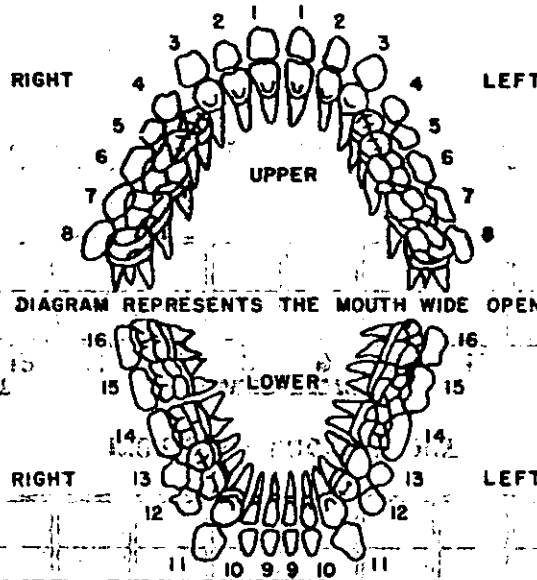

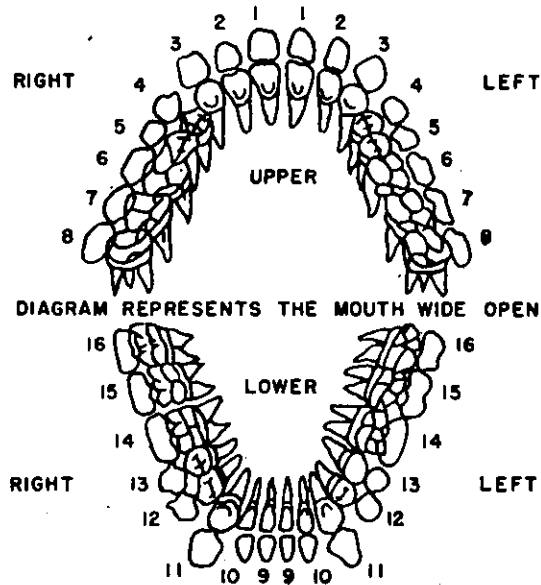


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN

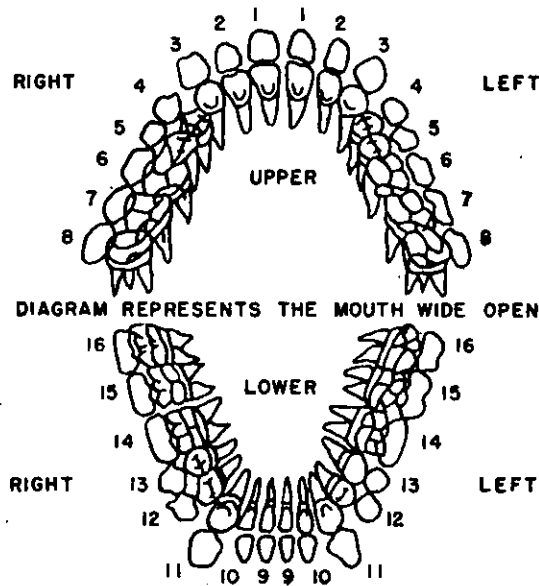


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN
