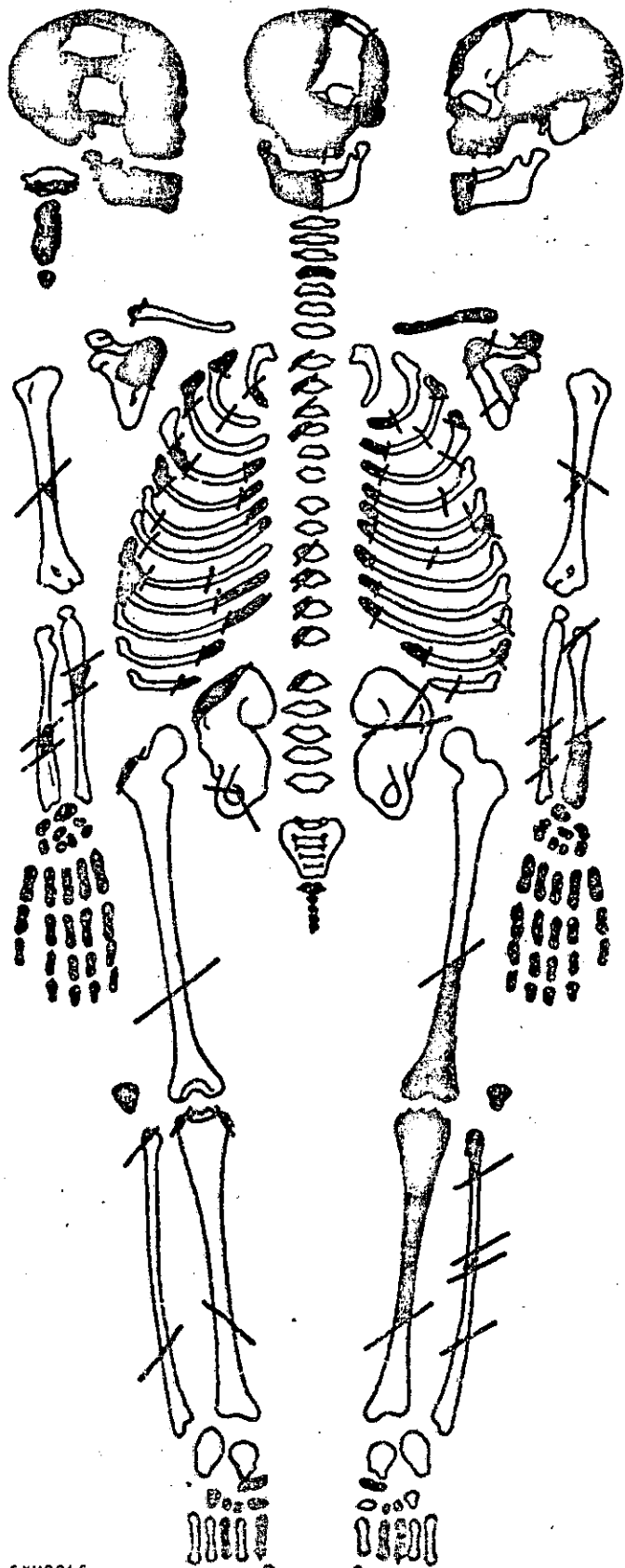
This caucasoid male of average height and muscularity. Due to missing anatomical portions of the skull it was determined to be average in size and oval in shape. The mandible is average in structure and width.
