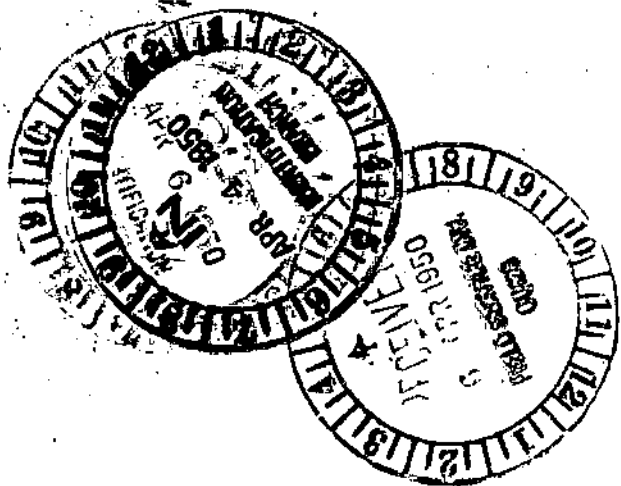

2. There is also inclosed a copy of letter of transmittal dated 5 May 1945, Headquarters, 109th Quartermaster (QM) Platoon, APO 709, The station listing of the Adjutant General indicates APO 709 to have been Guadalcanal, Solomon Islands.

3. It will be noted that the battle area given on the grave bag label is given as Tulagi, B.S.I. In view of the origin of the letter of transmittal, the place of burial may possibly have been a cemetery other than that given in basic letter.

4. In the event that identification of decedent can be established, it is requested that this Bureau be notified to enable further appropriate action.

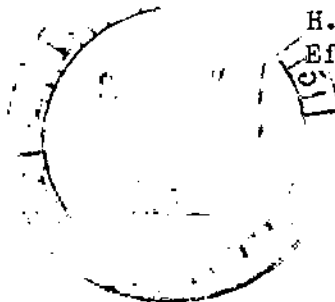

1. The Army Effects Bureau is in receipt of one ring recovered from the remains of Unknown decedent X-11, buried in U. S. Navy and U. S. Marine Corps Cemetery #1, Tulagi, B.S.I. Complete burial location was not furnished this Bureau. Inclosed herewith is copy of inventory of effects, WD, AGO Form 54 for Unknown decedent X-11, as prepared by John R. Nolan, 1st Lt., QMC, 109th QM (GR) Platoon, APO 709.

2. The following detailed description of the one ring received here for Unknown decedent X-11 is furnished for your information and file reference:

1 ea. silver colored ring. Not a very large size. This ring appears to be made from souvenir coin. On outside which is approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide is plain smooth surface. On inside of ring around edges is printed; "Georgias VID; G:BR:OMN: Rex F:D. Ind. Imp." Through center is plain even space and around outer edge is printed; "Florin-Australia."

3. It will be appreciated if the records of your office are checked and this Bureau informed if Unknown decedent X-11 has been officially identified. In the event sufficient information is not available at your office to establish identity of Unknown decedent, it is requested that this Bureau be informed in order that disposal may be made of the one ring received here.

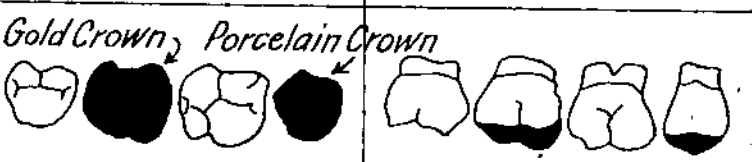

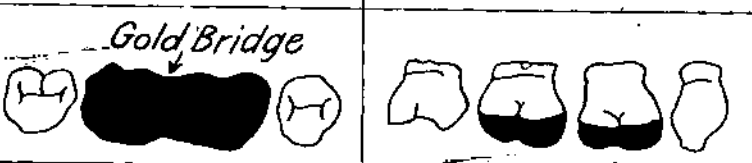

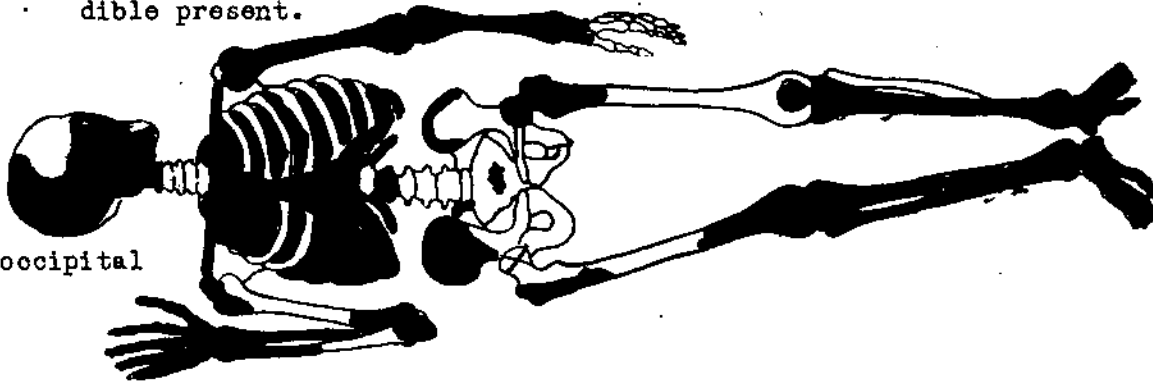

21. REMARKS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Picture a rather small short older man with apparently well developed back muscles as suggested by the rather large muscle marked shoulder blades.

The associated skull fragments indicate a rather small skull which is rather narrow and possibly had the usual amount of backhead projection.

The mandible fragments suggest rather large facial features. The face was probably on the long side and the chin eminence deep.

The extra parts listed as belonging to the first man, have been classified as CIL unknown X-571.

The extra parts listed as belonging to the second man have been classified as CIL unknown X-572.

The extra parts listed as belonging to the third man have been classified as CIL Unknown X-573.

The left ulna and radius listed as CIL Unknown X-573 could be part of the remains of CIL Unknown X-571.
