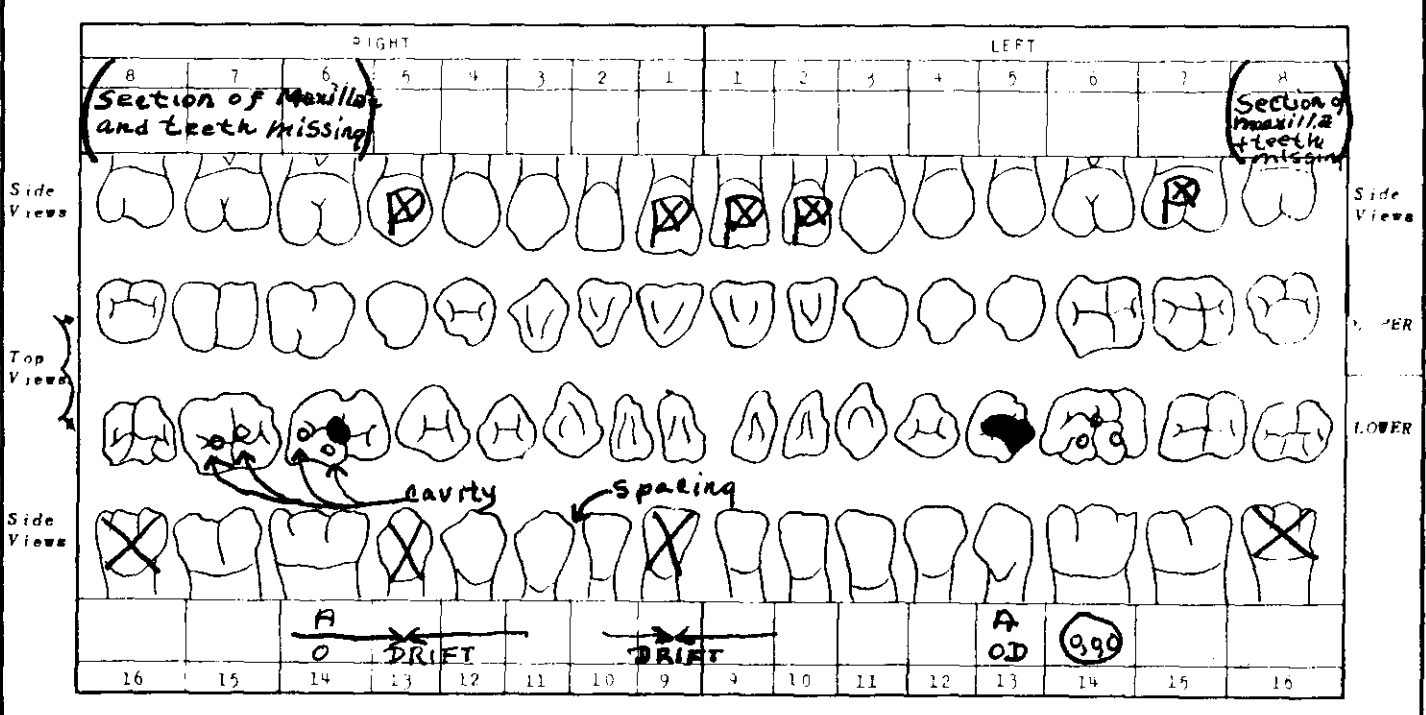

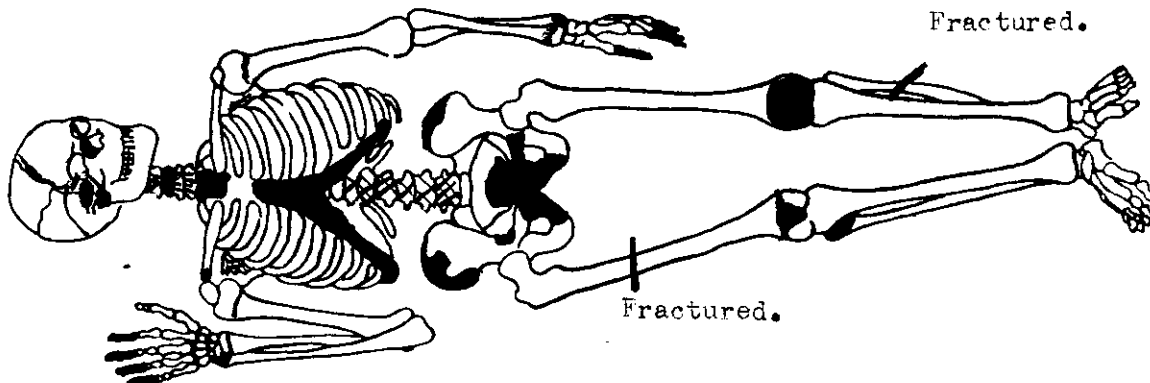

21. REMARKS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Picture a young man of 18 to 20 years of age, with small, slender build.

The skull is small and oval. The backhead projects. There is a left cranial asymmetry. The vault is somewhat ill filled. The forehead is narrow, and there is a very marked right facial asymmetry.

The face is average in size. The nose is straight with a wide bridge and an average nasal opening.

The palate is wide and present ⁽⁷⁶⁾ some alveolar prognathism.

The mandible is rather deep and has a median eminence. The angle of the lower jaw is very smooth with negative gonial flare.

Fluoroscopic examination positive. Teeth charted.
