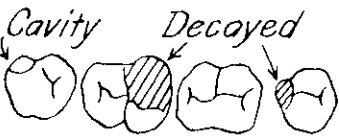

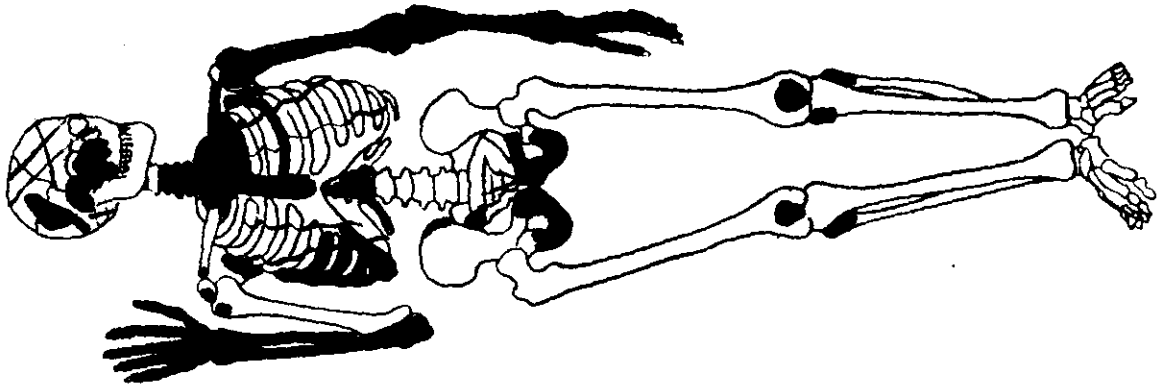

21. REMARKS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

In processing this remains, there was equipment found which included two (2) gas masks, two (2) .45 cal. rounds of ammunition, a spare parts kit for a B.A.R., canteens four (4), two (2) of which has names engraved. It is possible that the remains could be that of a squad leader, a BAR man or assistant BAR man.

Picture a short well developed young man 20 - 21 years of age, with a relatively large head. The skull is of average size, forms a rather broad oval in outline. The occipital and parietal bones are outstanding. It is likely the back projected. The vault is fairly wide across the parietals. The face is rather long and narrow with flat sides.

In profile the face is fairly straight. The chin appears to have average prominence. The chin presents a rather rounded eminence of average width.

Fluoroscopic examination negative. Tooth chart taken.
