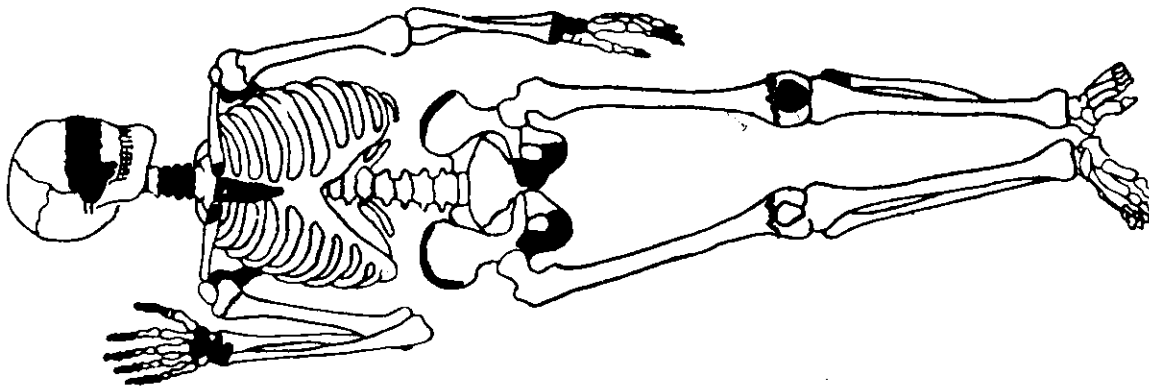

Picture a tall young man with light golden brown hair. The skull is average in size, oval in outline. The backhead has very little projection and the vault is quite high. The forehead has average slope. There is a flattening which extends from the crown to the neck. The face has average proportions and was rather large with left facial asymmetry. The region of the face around the cheek bones appears to be rather full. The line of the jaw appears to be average. The chin is prominent and forms a rather narrow bilateral eminence. Extra facets at ankle joints indicate a habit of squatting.
