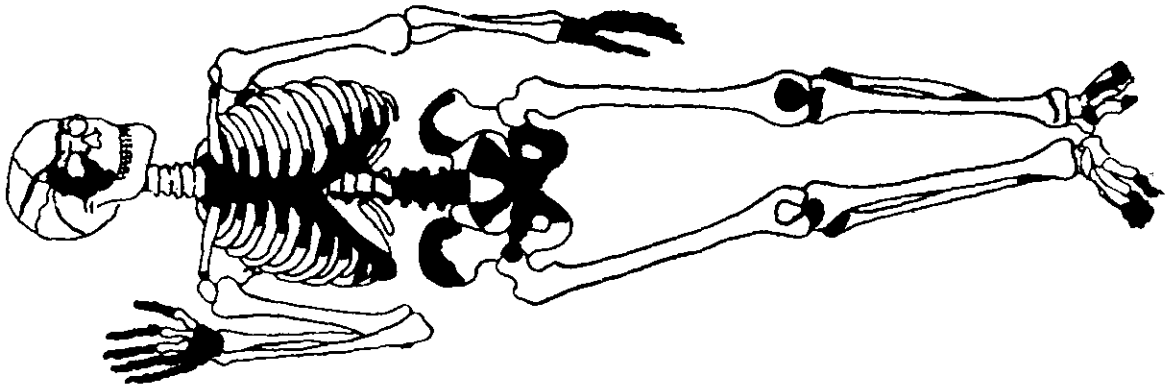

21. REMARKS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Picture an average-sized, well-muscled, light brown haired man in his middle twenties. Short, well-curved collar bones and robust arm bones indicate well-knit, muscular shoulders and perhaps a deep rib cage. The skull is medium in size, oval in outline and has a projecting backhead. An external occipital protuberance was undoubtedly palpable. The browridges are smaller than usual. The face is long and narrow with flat sides and left facial asymmetry. The nose, quite large and wider than usual at both root and bridge, forms a straight shape. The face is upright and the chin, which is prominent, forms a rounded eminence rather narrow in width. The lower borders of the face are flat.

Teeth chart taken. Fluoroscope report negative.
