2. SUMMARY

a. Private First Class Nelson died of shock and hemorrhage on
28 December 1942, and his remains were recovered from the field and re-
ported as re-buried 3 March 1943 in Plot A, Row 33, Grave 6, Army-Navy-
Marine Cemetery, Guadalcanal, Solomon Islands.

b. The remains of Unknown X-55 were buried 17 February 1943 in
Plot A, Row 13, Grave 4, Army-Navy-Marine Cemetery, Guadalcanal, Solomon
Islands.

c. In March 1948 the remains from Plot A, Row 33, Grave 6, Army-Navy-Marine Cemetery, Guadalcanal were examined at the Central Identification Laboratory, and Form 1044 was accomplished and compared with the original dental chart of Private First Class Nelson obtained from The Quartermaster General with unfavorable results.

d. In February 1948 the remains of Unknown X-55, Plot A, Row 13, Grave 4, Army-Navy-Marine Cemetery, Guadalcanal, were examined at the Central Identification Laboratory, and Form 1044 was accomplished and compared with the original dental chart of Private First Class Nelson obtained from The Quartermaster General with very favorable results.

e. One (1) original Identification tag reading: Paul Y. Nelson, 36030507, T-42, Kinca Nelson, Eashy, North Dakota, O P, was also found with the remains from Plot A, Row 13, Grave 4, Army-Navy-Marine Cemetery, Guadalcanal, Solomon Islands.

3. Conclusions

a. That Private First Class Nelson died of shock and hemorrhage and the remains erroneously marked after burial.

b. That the remains now designated as Unknown X-55 are those of Private First Class Nelson by comparison of dental record from The Quartermaster General and finding of one (1) original Identification tag reading: Paul Y. Nelson, 36030507, T-42, Kinca Nelson, Eashy, North Dakota, O P, with the remains of Unknown X-55.

c. That the remains now designated as Private First Class Nelson could never have been identified by comparison of dental charts.

4. Recommendations

a. That the remains now designated as Unknown X-55, Plot A, Row 13, Grave 4, Army-Navy-Marine Cemetery, Guadalcanal, be declared to be positively identified as Private First Class Paul Y. Nelson, 36030507, USA.


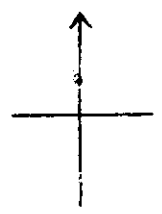


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN
