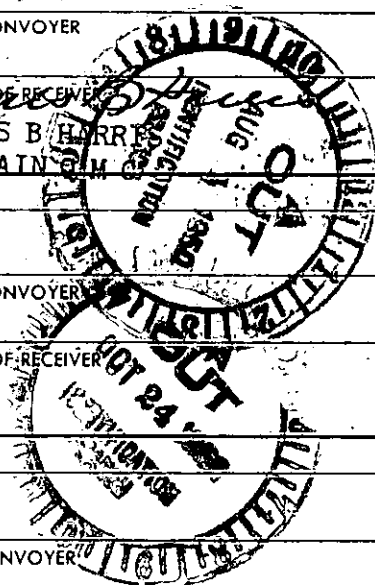

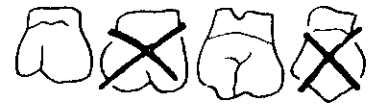

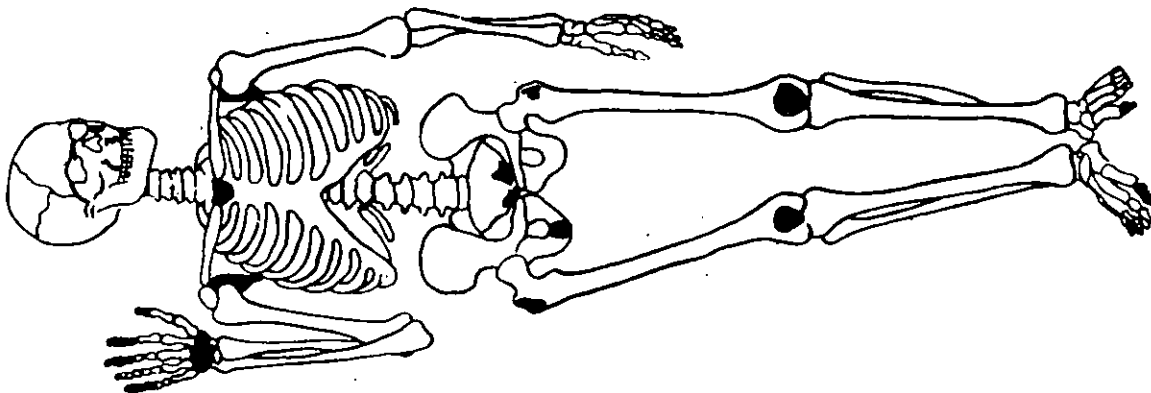

21. REMARKS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Picture an average sized man in his early twenties. The skull is a small average in size and has a broad oval outline. The vault is rather wide. There is small back-head projection and a noticeable flat area which extends up to the crown (lambdoid flattening). The forehead is high and narrow with little slope. The face has average proportions with a noticeably narrow lower face. The mouthparts project leaving a receding chin. The nose was rather prominent with a short bridge. The line of the lower jaw is quite short. The chin eminence is of average width and of a slight bilateral type.

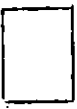
