The remains now designated Unanown X-70054 and X-70055 were recovered from cultivated field, the property of a Judge Vincenzo Formica, located approximately six (6) kilometers southeast of AFDEA (F-837308), Italy. Remnants of US type equipment were found with the scattered portions of regains.

The remains X-70054 consist of the major portion of a skull; an almost complete mandible; shafts of the right and left humerus; a broken right femur, and a portion of the pelvis. More than half of the teeth are post-humously missing, and there are no fillings in teeth present. Unknown X-70055 consists of only the major portion of a skull.



#### NARRATIVE OF INVESTIGATION

#### I. ACT ONITY AND LATIERS INVESTIGATED:

On 21 November 1953 while investigating recovery reports of World war II remains at the ABAC office in Rome, Italy the undersigned investigators were given a report from the cemetery superintendent at Nettuno. This report concerned the finding of partial remains by Judge Vincenzo Formica, Pretura of Anzio, on his property near Aprilia. He believed the remains were those of an American soldier because of the US Army equipment present.

#### II. r'lnuTn(65:

We visited Judge Formica at his farm on 24 November 1953. This property is located approximately six (6) kms southeast of ardea (F 837/308) and consists of several fields under cultivation. Near the edge of one slowed field we were shown some portions of skull, arm, pelvis and leg bones. With these portions were sieces of wool 0D blanket and US type boncho. An examination of the remains revealed the presence of two (2) deceased as indicated by major portions of two (2) skulls. These portions had been found scattered over a large area. A search was made in an attempt to find additional portions on the surface and possible evidence of actual graves. We did not find any additional portions but did see scattered bits of the poncho.

#### III. JUNG NUICH:

A sketch was made of the recovery site (see Exhibit "A"). The remains were designated SR # 752 and SR # 753 and were evacuated to the Graves Registration Central Identification Laboratory in Criesheim/Lain, Germany for further processing and research.


#### IV. MLCC. ENDATION:
