1. Data available in this office regarding subject remains states that the body was found on the beach at Sandur, Iceland. The remains had no identification tag or uniform but did have various types of Navy clothing (underwear similar to Navy type, rainproof parka, trousers bearing "Navy Department, Contract DA 0005 medium" and Navy type "jungle" cloth helmet). A U.S. Navy type life jacket was found in vicinity. Other clothing could not be identified as Navy. Certificate of Death states that it was impossible to obtain fingerprints of any value due to the flattening out and water logging of tissues. Because of the clothing on the remains, the decedent was regarded as U.S. Navy Deceased and so buried.

2. In view of the fact that latent fingerprints on file are complete at present time, and the fact that numerous inquiries to F.B.I. by Identification Branch fail to disclose any further information on deceased, this Branch proposes to bury remains as unknown in Long Island National Cemetery.

The other clothing could not be identified as Navy type. There was no uniform or civilian trousers and coat. A Westclox watch was found which was stopped at 6:30.

It was impossible to obtain finger prints of any value due to the flattening out and water logging of tissues. The skin of the right index finger was treated and painted with methylene blue. Copies of photographs are attached.

It is estimated that the body had been in the water 4 to 8 weeks. (Judging from condition of other bodies recovered from the water in this area.)

LONG, Earl Richard Jr., GM3c, USN -379-87-54 is reported to have been lost at sea from the S.S. Benjamin Williams on March 9, 1943. However it is not probable that the remains would have drifted from the location where LONG, E.R. was lost to Sandur.

In view of the fact that the remains had on some articles of clothing which were definitely U.S. Navy issue the remains were regarded as U. S. Navy Deceased and so buried.

These remains are registered as #33 in Burial Record (Dispensary, N.O.B. Iceland)
