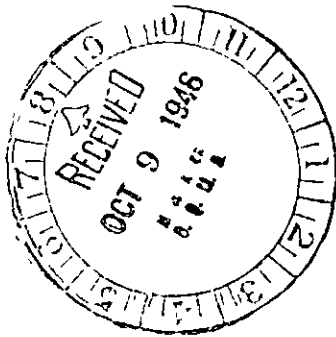

3. Records in this office show interment in U. S. Military Cemetery, Bari, Italy, Plot H, Row 9, Grave 1110, of T/Sgt. Thomas H. McDONALD, 38 379 003, 347 Bomb Sq. 99 Bomb Gp., KIA 24 August 1944 in plane crash at FOGGIA, Italy. Identification was established by tags.
