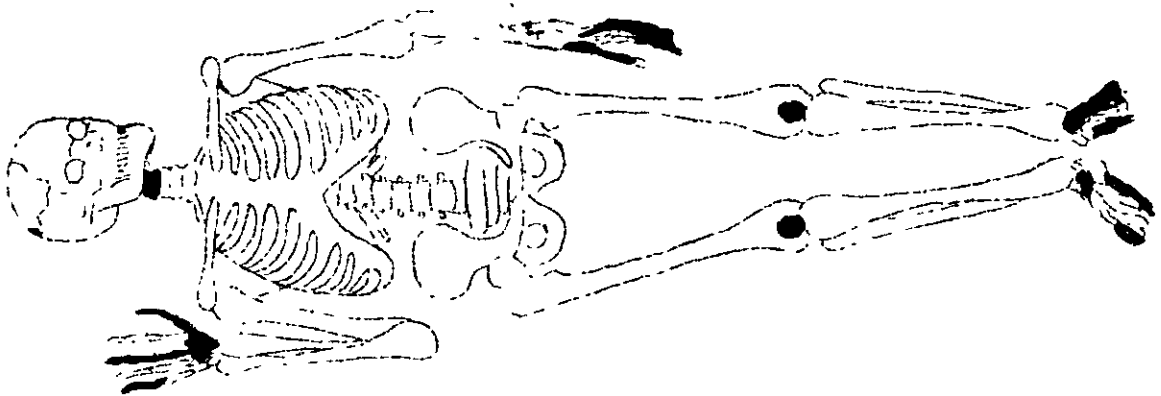

In the year nineteen hundred and forty-five on the sixth of April at 1700 hrs in the Commune's Office.

I, Cardone Flaminio, Chief Secretary, Civilian Affairs Official of the Loano Commune have been charged with the task of transcribing literally in this register the following announcement relevant to the recovery of a body. I received it from the City Guards Office of this Commune.

"Town of Loano - City Guard's Office - Certificate of recovery of a body.

In the year nineteen hundred and forty-five, on the sixth of April in the City Guard's Office of this Commune, I, the undersigned Andreta Albino, city guard employed by the Loano Commune, do hereby inform whomever may be concerned of the following:

✓ In the year 1945 on the 6th of April at 1430hrs in the seashore area near the mouth of the river Nimbalto, has been recovered a male body in a state of advanced decomposition, of the seeming age, of about 40 years, medium height, stout built, wearing an aviator's dresses. We were unable to find out the name of the deceased owing to lack of identification documents.

The body, after having been inspected by the Sanitary Officer, was taken to the cemetery for the burial ceremony.





**SUBJECT:** Report of Investigation

1. Submitted herewith is report of investigation concerning the recovery of the remains of Unknown American Airman X-287, interred in Plot 2-J, Row 94, Grave 4865, U. S. Military Cemetery, Castelfiorentino.

2. Remains were recovered from a separate grave, Civilian Cemetery, Loano, Italy, coordinates (20.8-41.3) Sh. 92-93, Map Reference 1/100,000, by investigation team led by Pfc. Keeling, 3 October 1946.

3. Excerpt of report submitted by Pfc. Keeling is as follows:

"Arriving about 9 AM, 3 October 1946 at Loano, went directly to Civilian Cemetery where after a discussion with the caretaker, Mario Zunino, told us that there were two American Airmen buried in the cemetery. According to the caretaker Unknown American Airman X-287 had died in an airplane crash and had been picked up at sea, (See attached statement). No other statements could be obtained."

5. The remains have been reentered as those of Unknown American Airman X-287, Plot 2-J, Row 94, Grave 4865, U. S. Military Cemetery at Castelfiorentino and reports of interment will be forwarded with weekly report of 6-12 October 1946.
