

RUMARKS: Remains recovered in skeletal state from grave approx 400 yards southsouthwest of Pangam-ni village; approx 1000 yards north-northwest of Iram-ni village and approx 1100 yards west-southwest of Taejong village. A Korean stated that he had seen some bones in his wheat field on 5 October 1951 and that he covered them up. He did not know if the remains were American or Korean. The people of Pangam village buried the remains. Mr. Ku Hae Kong stated that Kim Yong Dae, now in Pusan, address unknown, buried the remains about the middle of November 1950. There had been fighting in the Pangam village area on the 6th and 7th of August 1950. Later, American personnel come to this village and found two (2) American remains on the mountain in this area. Soil from grave sifted and thorough search conducted over large surrounding area but no identification media found.
