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REMARKS:

On 25 November 1952 this remains was recovered by a S&R team, led by Pvt Walter P. Ambrose, at grid coord CT 372218. Directions to the remains were furnished by Pfc Irvin Napier Jr. of Btry B, 15th FA Bn, who discovered the remains. (See attached statement by Pfc Irvin Napier Jr).

The only identification media found on the remains was one metal tag, resembling an ID tag, bearing the number: 466. A skirmish line made up of the members of the S&R team was utilized in making a careful search of the area for missing portions and other ID media. The result of the search was negative.

Examined at the 293rd QM Gr Reg Co Mortuary, the remains was found to be in skeletal state with the following portions believed to be missing: cranium and mandible, enciform process, (3) vertebrae, (2) ribs, coccyx, left patella, (101) hand and foot bones.
