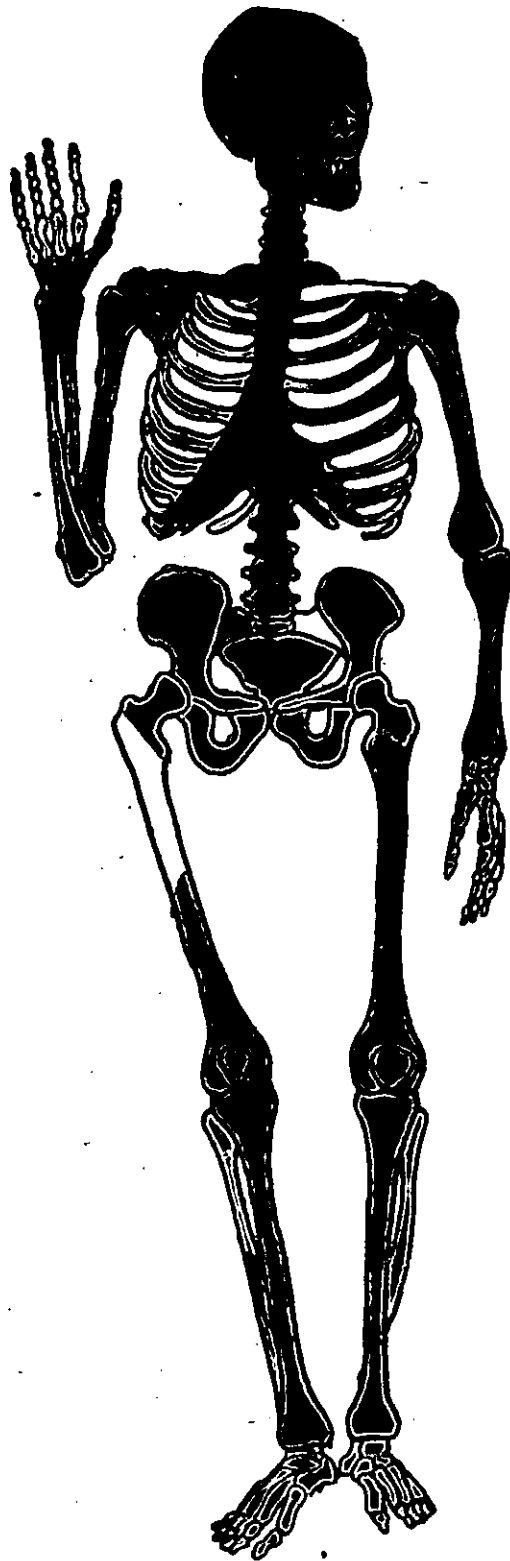

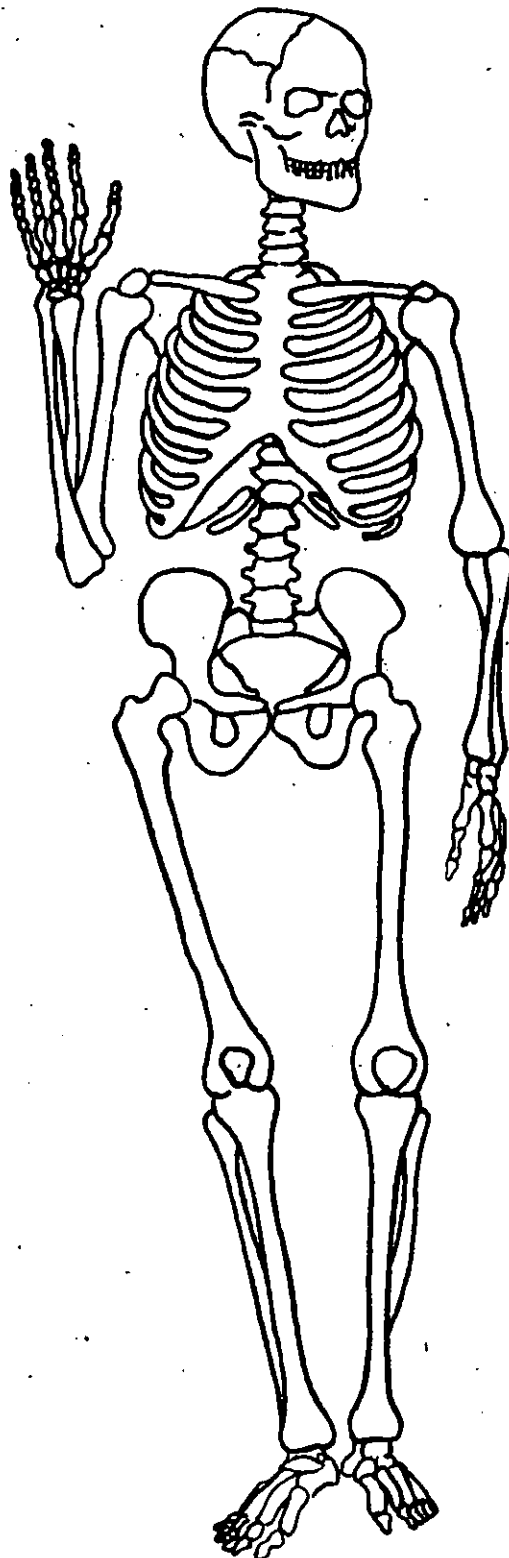

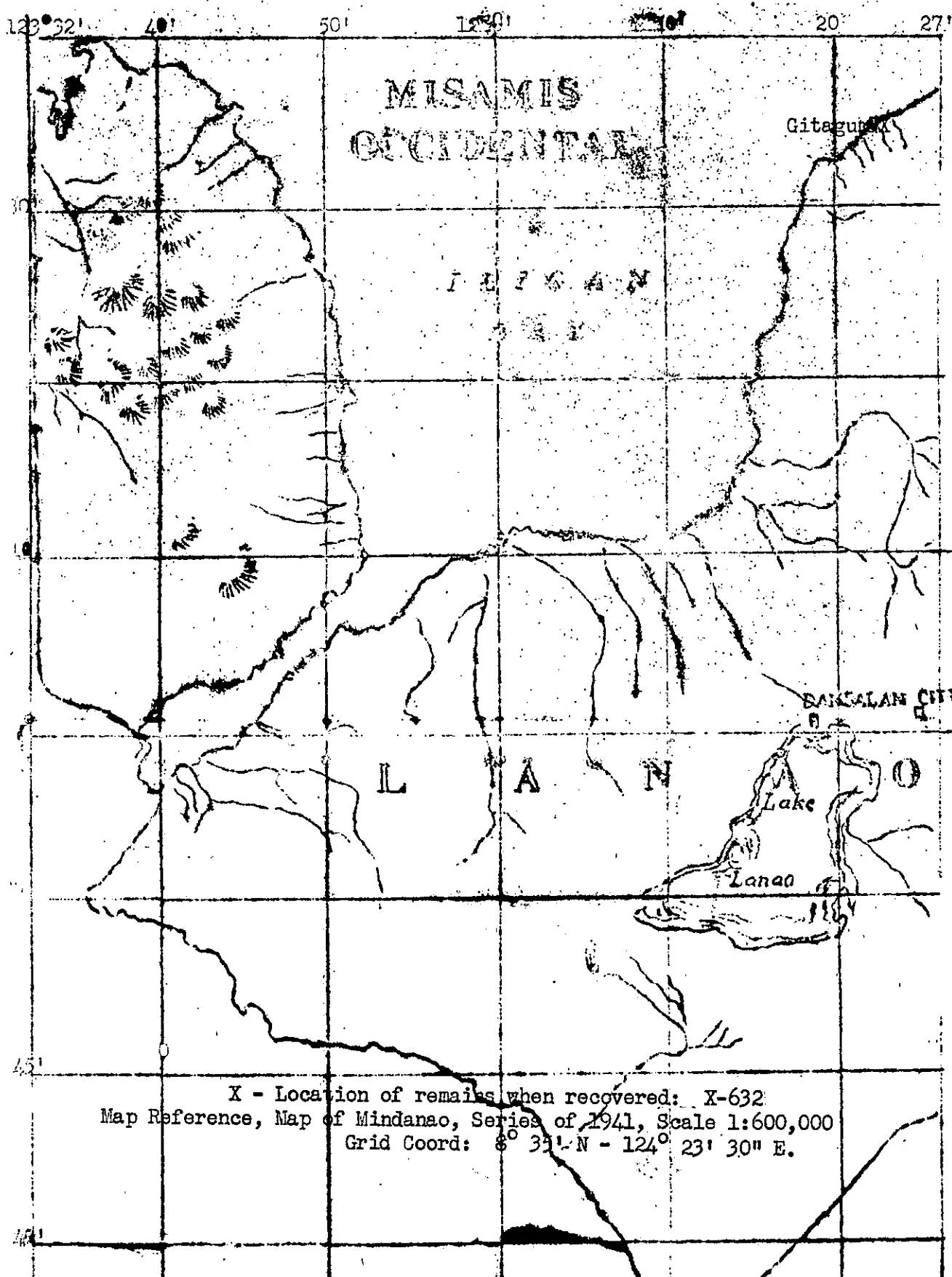
REMARKS:

Went to Gitagum June 13, 1947 to recover the remains of Sgt. Barney Allen accompanied by Charlie Cooper civilian who buried him and knew where the grave was. Arriving there, we found that his remains had been removed. To make sure, we proceeded to disinter the grave but all that was found was what apparently a fore arm bone, two small pairs of ribs, and a flying suit that he was buried in. Being unable to find any more parts of the body, we returned to FS-170. We secured a sworn statement from the vice Mayor saying that some time in 1946 two GI's and one civilian removed the above named remains.

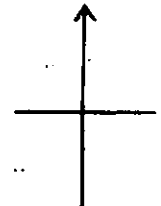
