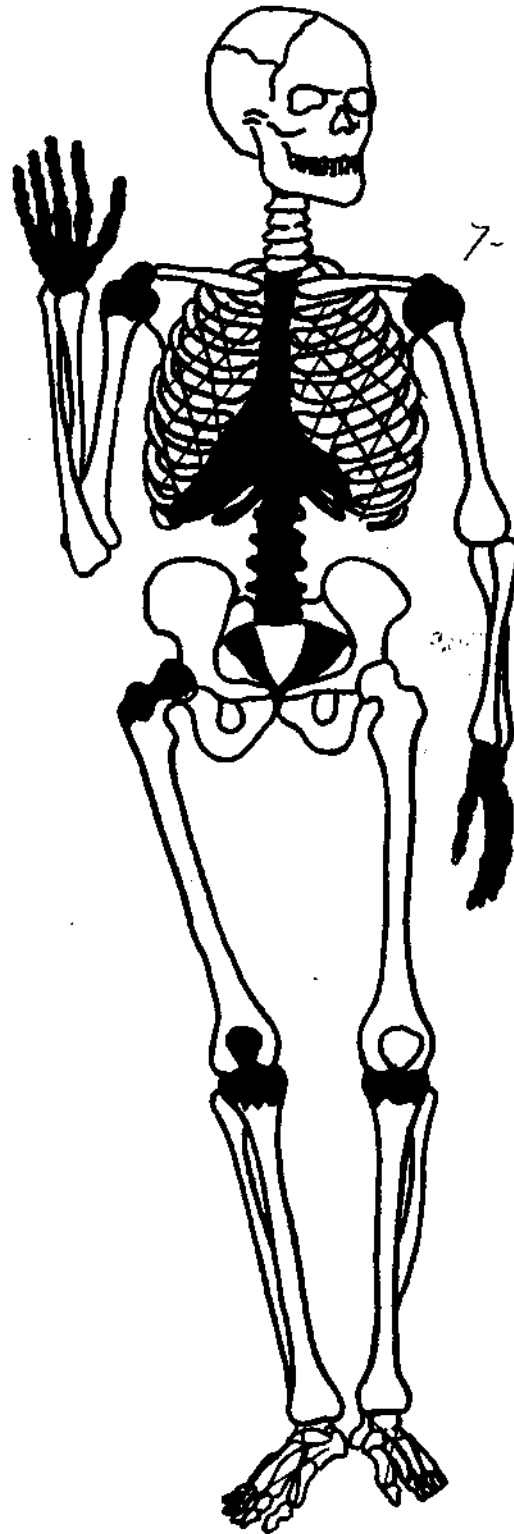

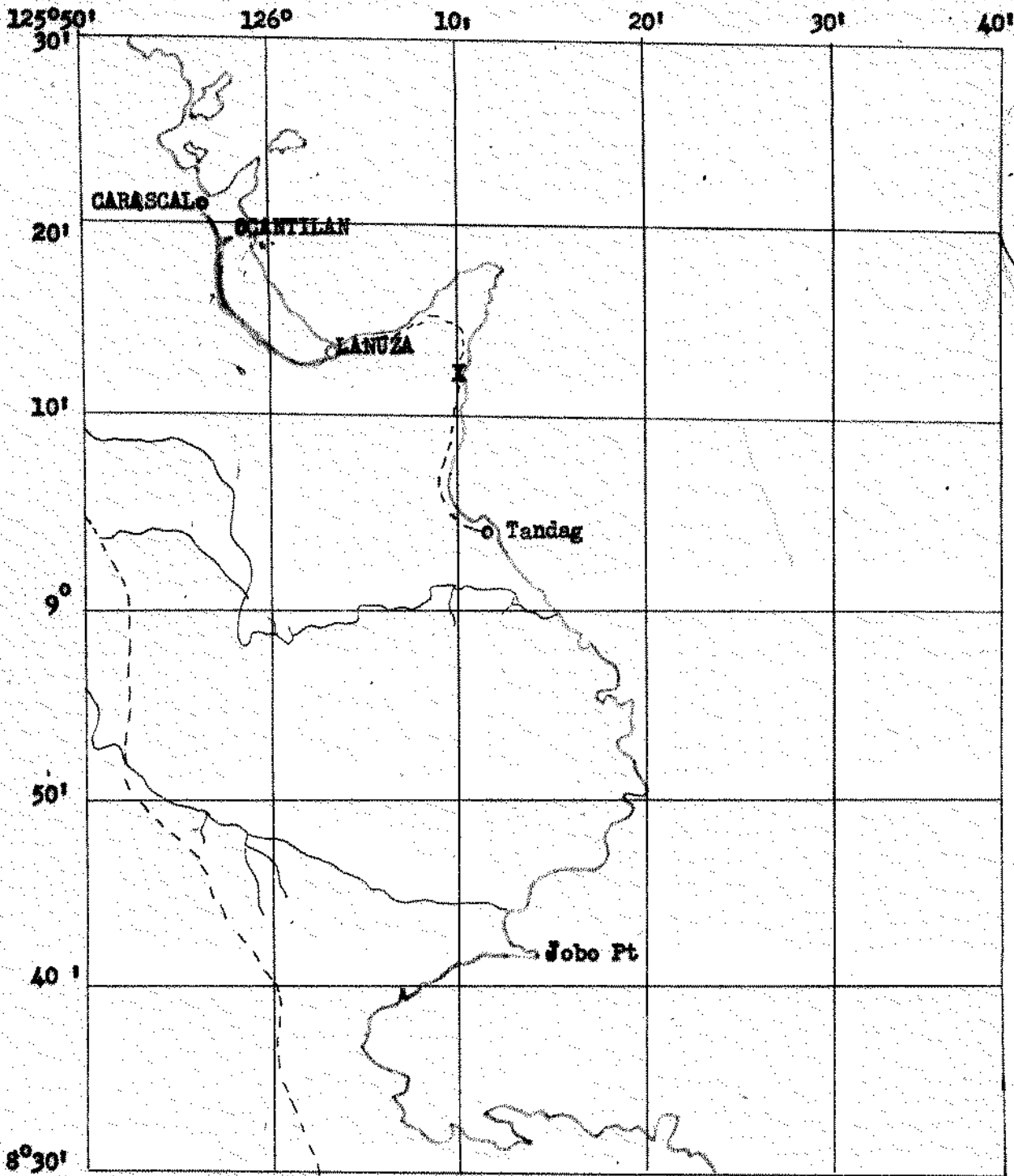

When they (Americans) were overturned in Point Cawit 4 kilometers from the seashore as soon as they reached the shore the 11 Americans lived at home. I was taking care of them until they recovered from their sickness. We were in Madrelino, Lanuza. For several months we transferred to Tigao and we lived in the evacuation place. After several days he was sick with malaria and I was taking care of him while he was sick. I was in his deathbed until his last breath. I buried him in the civilian cemetery in Tigao Tandag, Surigao.
