1. IDENTIFICATION, PREPARATION OF BODY, BURIAL AND MARKINGS OF GRAVES OF ISOLATED BURIALS. Have body examined to establish IDENTITY. If body is unidentified, take four (4) sets of fingerprints of all available fingers. Complete the following:

Wrap and tie body securely in a blanket, pad covering, canvas or other suitable substance. Dig grave to five feet or in hasty burials, to sufficient depth to prevent destruction of body or loss of identity. Place only one body in grave. Securely fasten one identification tag to body. Remove other identification tag and attach to grave marker (when body is disinterred or properly recorded, remove and forward to BuPers, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard, as indicated). If no tag is present, make a notation with pencil of identifying data on form in duplicate, place in bottle, canteen, cap, or other available container which can be made watertight, bury one with remains and the other, (1) foot below grave marker. If no tag is available, write identifying data on marker. When tags are not available, use other suitable means to identify grave as a military grave.

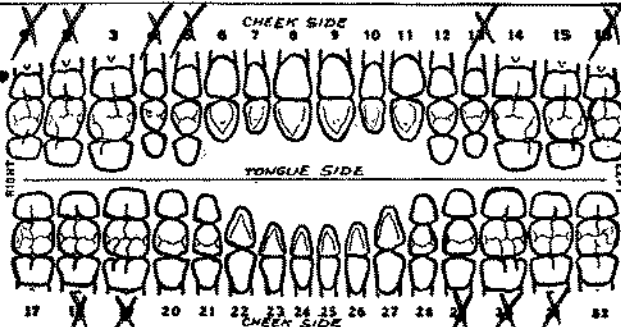
2. LOCATION OF GRAVE: Report burials in established cemeteries by plot, and grave number. For all other burials, prepare sketch in space provided below; and give location by means of map references, or by reference to prominent, permanent landmarks. Information must be specific, accurate, complete. Stand at foot of grave facing head to determine bodies buried to the left and right.
