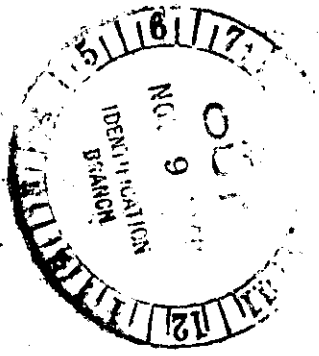

2. The above named deceased were killed in action 3 November 1944 when the transport SS Mathew P. Deady was attacked by an enemy suicide airplane while anchored in Tacloban Bay, Leyte, P.I. The complete casualty list as prepared by 'OO 21 May 1945 is believed to be accurate, however, it does not agree with the number of casualties reported by the U. S. Navy 15 June 1944. It is quite possible that other deceased still carried as missing in action were casualties aboard this ship.

3. In the two individual identifications recommended the identifications are based entirely on the available Army dental records of the deceased. Under the circumstances which surround the entire incident it is considered that this basis does not warrant conclusive individual identifications.

4. Two Navy personnel, S 1/C John L. Corbell, 8860299, and S 1/C Robert W. Lollar, 8718295, were declared missing in action after the bombing of the Deady. Remains have never been recovered and identified as being those of these decedents. Forms 371 for the two deceased are inclosed herewith.

5. As stated in paragraph #2, above, there is some doubt as to the actual number of casualties from this incident. Furthermore, it is known that some personnel aboard the Deady jumped overboard in an attempt to save themselves. It is quite possible that bodies washed up on the shore after the incident were, in fact, deceased from the Deady.

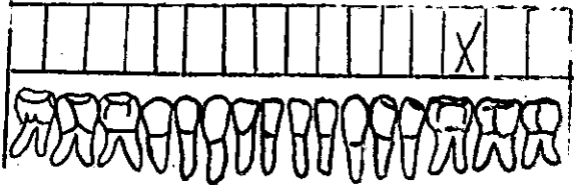
