(1) Death occurred on board LST 552 anchored in San Pedro Bay, Leyte Island at approximately 1000 hours on above mentioned date and was the result of bomb explosion from enemy dive bomber.

(2) Sgt Dollins, at the time, was seen on that portion of the deck struck by the bomb.

(3) Two members of this organization who remained on board to render assistance in identifying the dead identified Sgt Dollins among the other casualties.

(4) Sgt Dollins died as a result of multiple shrapnel wounds over the entire body as stated by aforementioned personnel who identified him at approximately 1030 hours, 25 Oct 1944.

2. Deceased was placed on a truck along with other dead and taken ashore for burial in a cemetery near Tacloban, Leyte.

3. Exact location and name of cemetery are not known to this headquarters.
