1. A review of records in this office definitely reveals that two Unknowns were designated as X-82, Palawan No. 1.

2. The Unknown X-82 referred to in paragraph 2 of preceding Indorsement was originally interred in common Grave 13, Row 2, American Section, Palawan No. 1 Cemetery, together with Unknowns X-1 and X-83. Interment was made on 12 March 1945.

3. The other Unknown X-82 (now designated X-3459, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila) was interred in Grave 152, Row 16, on 3 November 1945. This Unknown is the one referred to in basic communication and is not in any way associated with the crew of aircraft No. PB4Y-1-38735.

4. With reference to Report of Reinterment mentioned in paragraph 2 of basic letter, a further investigation reveals that the organization listed thereon as "Plane No. PB4Y-1-38735" and date of death as "17 February 1945" were added in ink (handwritten) to our file copy of the report by one with initials "JR". This information was evidently obtained from records pertinent to the other Unknown X-82 associated with the said aircraft since no records are available justifying the association of this Unknown with the crashed Navy plane.

5. For your further reference, enclosed herewith are true copies of original Reports of Interment and Reinterment for the two (2) Unknowns both designated as X-82, Palawan No. 1, and also for Unknowns X-1 and X-83, Palawan No. 1.

1. A review of records in this office definitely reveals that two Unknowns were designated as X-82, Palawan No. 1.

2. The Unknown X-82 referred to in paragraph 2 of preceding interment was originally interred in common Grave 13, Row 2, American Section, Palawan No. 1 Cemetery, together with Unknowns X-1 and X-83. Interment was made on 12 March 1945.

3. The other Unknown X-82 (now designated X-3459, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila) was interred in Grave 152, Row 16, on 3 November 1945. This Unknown is the one referred to in basic communication and is not in any way associated with the crew of aircraft No. PB4Y-1-38735.

4. With reference to Report of Reinterment mentioned in paragraph 2 of basic letter, a further investigation reveals that the organization listed thereon as "Plane No. PB4Y-1-38735" and date of death as "17 February 1945" were added in ink (handwritten) to our file copy of the report by one with initials "JR". This information was evidently obtained from records pertinent to the other Unknown X-82 associated with the said aircraft since no records are available justifying the association of this Unknown with the crashed Navy plane.

5. For your further reference, enclosed herewith are true copies of original Reports of Interment and Reinterment for the two (2) Unknowns both designated as X-82, Palawan No. 1, and also for Unknowns X-1 and X-83, Palawan No. 1.
