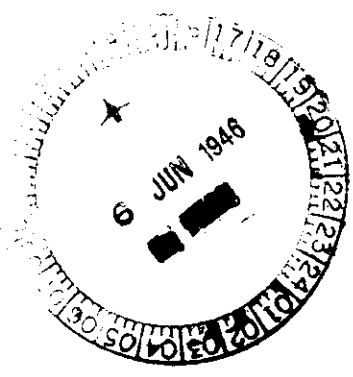
1. Records this headquarters indicate that a single engine fighter crashed on Danawan Island, sometime during the month of January 1946. The plane burned and identification of any plane serial numbers was impossible. The only identifying object found was an automatic pistol caliber 45, serial number 1060710, which was removed from the body of the aviator who at present is interred in USAF Cemetery Leyte, I., P. I. as unknown X-423.

2. Request records your headquarters be reviewed so as to establish a possible identity of aviator.

SUBJECT: Remains of unknown aviator

TO: Graves Registration.

1. Guerrilla forces stationed on SIBUTU ISLAND delivered remains to this station on MAY 10, 1945.

a. The guerrillas state that the remains were recovered on DANAWAN ISLAND.

b. They state that the plane, a single engine fighter, crashed on DANAWAN ISLAND sometime during the month of JANUARY, 1945. The plane burned and identification of any plane serial numbers was impossible.


c. One pistol, automatic caliber 45, serial number 1060710, was removed from body.

d. No other means of identifying body were found.

2. Remains are being shipped to ZAMBOANGA by aircraft on 12 May 1945
