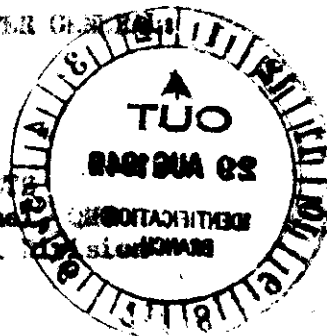

BASIS FOR DECLARING REMAINS IDENTIFIABLE
AS A GROUP

1. Above listed casualties were crew members of an AC TBM 1c, SN-25715 reported missing on a strafing mission on Negros Island, 13 September 1944, and was last seen over Lanoy-Lanoy Airfield, Negros Island.

2. The remains of Ens. Daniel LANER, 304256, pilot of TBM 1c, SN-25715 have been identified and interred in USAF Cemetery Leyte #1, Grave 6599. (See Incls 1 and 2).

3. Time, place and cause of death of UNIFORM X-2274, AGRS Mausoleum are in agreement with data on NACR, COMC Form 371 for AOM 3/c KRANTZ and AOM 2/c LANFORD, and ROS for Ensign Daniel LANER, the other crew member. (See Incls 1, 2, 3, 4 and 10).

4. Investigation was conducted relative to the case of A/C TBM-1c Bu No. 25715, missing 13 Sept 1944, piloted by Ensign LANER. Remains of the victims were recovered previously by Philippine Scout Field Operating team as per information from informant, probably the Field Operating team of 2nd Lt. Abraham E. Shapiro, who recovered the remains of UNK X-2274. (See Incls 7 and 8).

5. Informant, Idelfonso Olvido, states that an American plane crashed on or about 13 Sept 1944, no crew member survived, and that Sept 1947 a searching party of Philippine Scouts came and investigated the crash, recovering some remains in the vicinity and some from under the wreckage. (See Incl 9).

6. The dental chart for UNIFORM X-2274 is in agreement with dental data on OQMG Form 371 for AOM 3/c WEAVER. (See Incls 1 and 5).

7. The height for UNIFORM X-2274 compares favorably with data on OQMG Form 371 for AOM 3/c WEAVER. (See Incls 1 and 6).

8. However, due to the condition of the remains, fragmented circumstances of death and recovery, individual identification would be speculative.

9. It is recommended that UNIFORM X-2274, (Formerly UNIFORM X-464, USAF Secretary Leyte #1) 4225 Mausoleum, Manila, P.I. (Manila 10, Bay I, Crypt 3995), be identified as the recoverable remains of:

REPORT OF INVESTIGATION

1. On the morning of 14 December 1945, a farmer by the name of Apolinario (Surname unknown), reported to Lt ROBERTO R DE LUZURIAGA, 42d MP Co. (PA), the presence of human bones near a supposed U.S. plane (Curtis Hell-Cat) at Hda Dango, an hacienda located on the highway going from Saravia to Victorias. On 29 Dec 1945, an investigation was made by Lt ABRAHAM E CHAPIRO of this Headquarters.

FINDINGS:

1. The plane was shot down sometime in Sept 1944 and at present only a portion of the wing, fuselage and engine is left. The plane is a Curtis Hell-Cat and the only identification found is a serial number found on the nose of the plane near the propeller. This serial number was in two parts as follows:

The wing had the number 56 on it.

2. There is no definite knowledge that the bones found was that of the pilot of the plane numbered above as it is quite possible that additional planes or parts of planes may have been removed from the scene by natives.
