SUBJECT: Request for Discontinuance of Active Search

TO : Quartermaster General, Washington 25, D.C.

1. Attention is invited to inclosed correspondence.
2. T/5 Abraham H. Freedman, 32977164, and Pvt. George Shaw Jr., 18030270, were both members of a patrol operating near Balite, Leyte, Philippine Islands on 30 December 1944. The patrol encountered superior enemy forces and as a result T/5 Freedman was killed and Pvt Shaw wounded. Due to heavy enemy pressure the patrol was forced to withdraw, leaving the dead and wounded. Attempts were made shortly afterwards by a reenforced patrol to reach the location where Freedman and Shaw were last seen, but was unable to do so.
3. A search was made by Hq Base K, USAFWESPAC on 2 February 1946 extending to 11 February 1946 after the possible recovery of the remains of Freedman and Shaw. Partial remains of one body were found, a toothchart was accomplished and interment of the remains effected in USAF Cemetery Leyte #1.
4. The tooth chart referred to in paragraph 3 above (Unknown X-477, USAF Cemetery Leyte #1) was forwarded to the OQMG for comparison with existing records of Freedman and Shaw. Inasmuch as the toothchart did not indicate whether the missing teeth were due to extraction or missing posthumously, comparison could not be made.
5. A corrected tooth chart for Unknown X-477 was submitted by USAF Cemetery Leyte #1. Comparison of it, with the inclosed toothcharts of Freedman and Shaw, proved unfavorable.

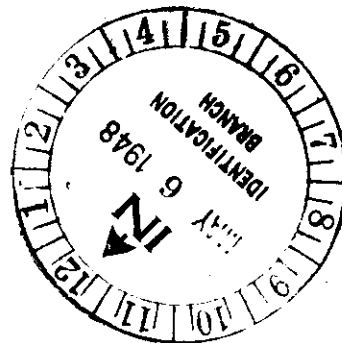

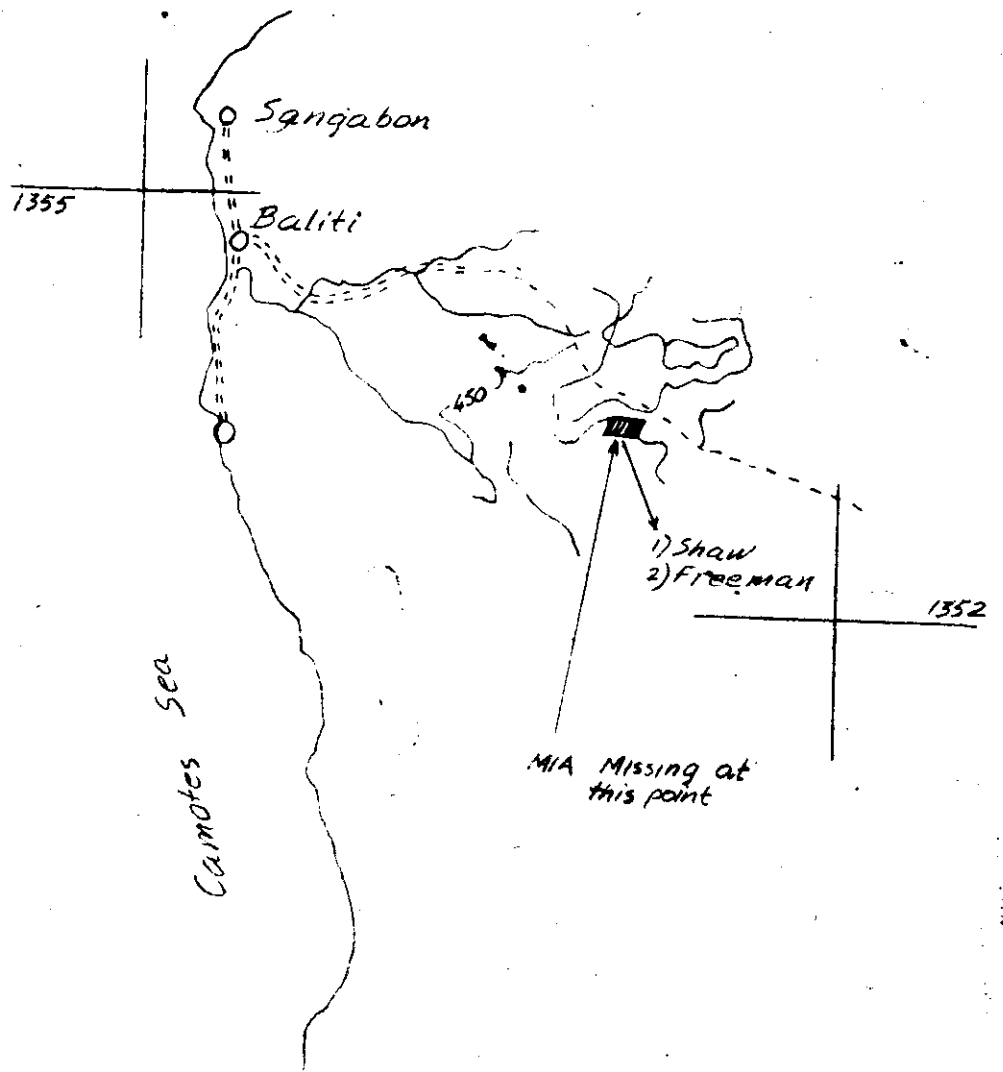

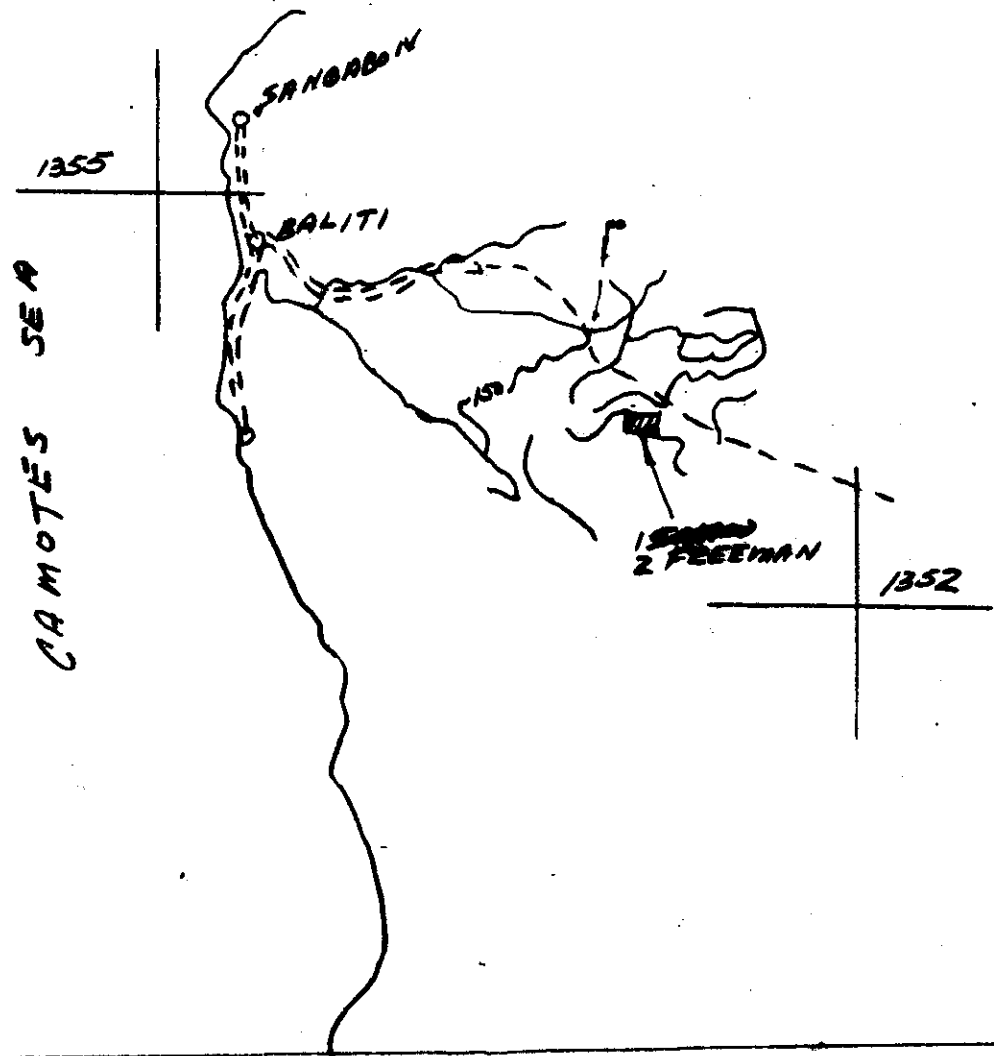
