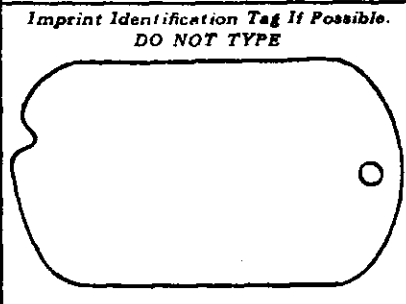

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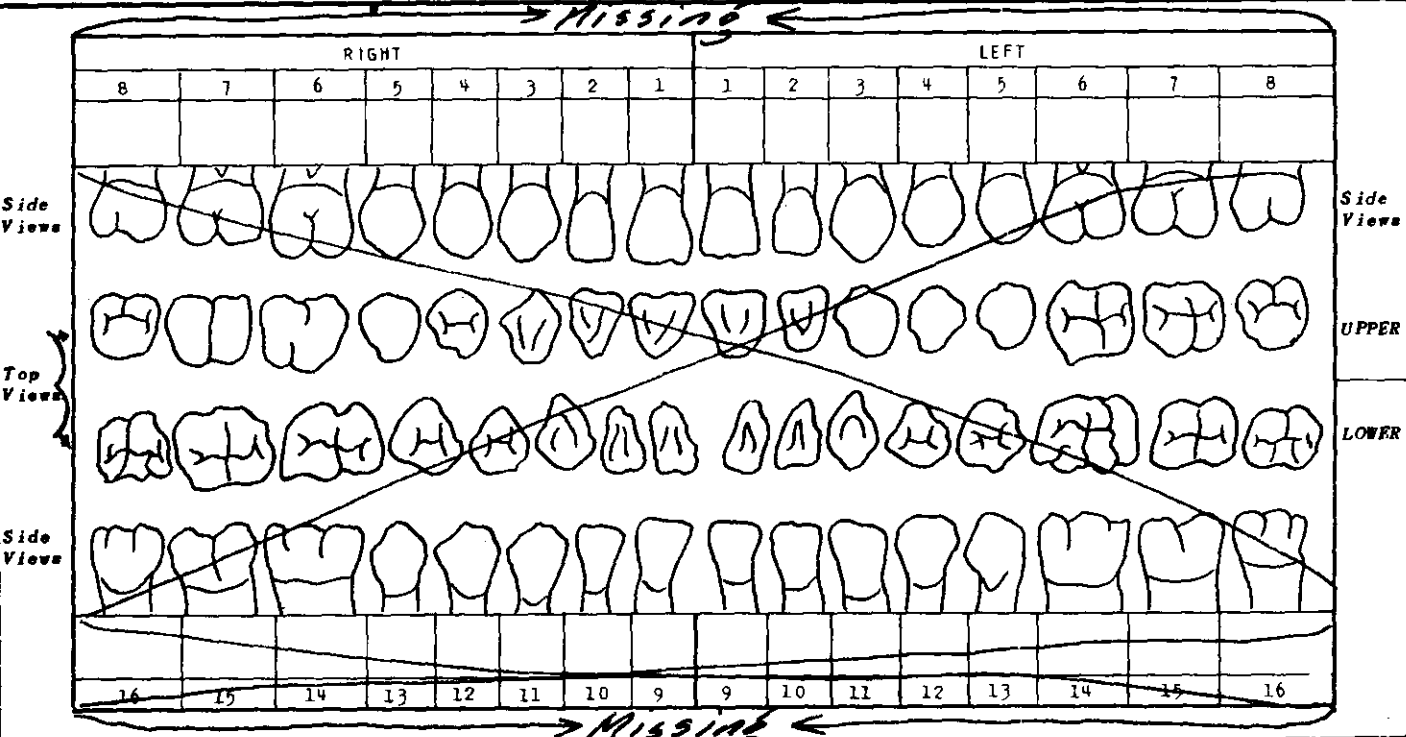

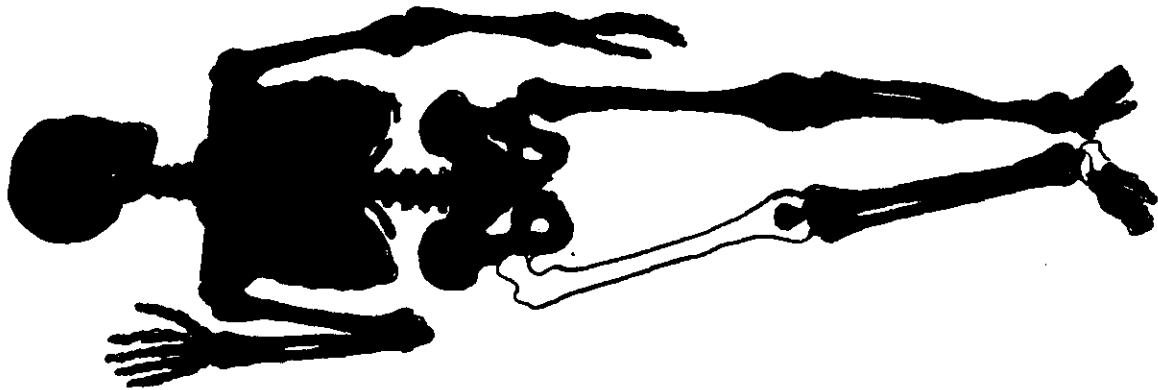

21. REMARKS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

In processing this case (Formerly Unk X-2286, USAF Cem Manila #2, Luzon, P.I., two (2) remains were found, because of bone structure we were able to segregate, and the two remains were assigned Nos Unk A-2877-A and Unk A-2877-B.

This remains is one of a group disinterred at POW Camp, Cabanatuan, Luzon, P.I., Grave No. 1102, Row No. 0, Plot No. 11. Circumference of the skull cannot be determined. Skull missing. Tooth chart impossible due to condition of remains, no teeth found. Estimated weight of remains 1 1/2 lbs.
