1. With reference to clarification requested in basic communication,
the following information is hereby submitted:

a. Two (2) remains were originally recovered as Joseph Johnson,
19056236, and subsequently interred in USM Cemetery Manila No. 2, in two
(2) separate graves and on different dates.

b. The first recovery was from Little Baguio Cemetery (Plot 1,
Row 2, Grave 15) and reinterred in Manila No. 2 (Plot 2, Row 22, Grave 2796)
on 17 January 1946. This was later redesignated X-3688, Manila No. 2, then
stored as X-1630, AMM Museum, and finally interred in Ft. McKinley as
Unidentifiable.

c. The second recovery was also from Little Baguio Cemetery (Plot
1, Row 6, Grave 16) and reinterred in Manila No. 2 (Plot 4, Row 1, Grave 122).
This grave location at Manila No. 2 was previously occupied by David E.
Julius, 15346212, which when visited was recognized by the second recovery
as shown by Report of Interment, dated 23 May 1947. This recovery is the
one now designated X-4220, Manila No. 2 and concurrently USM No. 904.

2. Based on the foregoing information, it is believed that no dis-
crepancy exists in the accomplishment of the Report of Storage, dated
10 May 1950, indicating Johnson X-4220 previously interred in Plot 4, Row 1,
Grave 122, USM Cemetery Manila No. 2.

3. For your further reference, enclosed herewith is a copy of Report
of Interment, dated 23 May 1947, showing that the second recovery was
interred in Plot 4, Row 1, Grave 122, which was formerly occupied by David
E. Julius.

1. Reference is made to the attached Report of Storage dated 10 May 1950 for Unit X-4220 which indicates original interment in USAF Cemetery Manila #2, P.I. Plot 4, Row 3, Grave 322. Records of this Office indicates that Unit X-1650 (X-3488 USAF Manila #2) was formerly the remains of Joseph Johnson, 19056236 which were declared unidentifiable and permanently interred in Ft. McKinley. (Burial Report attached) The remains previously interred in USAF Cem Manila #2, Plot 4, Row 3, Grave 322 were shipped to the United States under the current death program as David E. Julius 15346212 7 May 1947.
