This remains is one of a group disinterred at POW Camp, Cabanatuan, Luzon, P.I. Grave No. 420, Row No. 4, Plot No. 4. In processing this case (Formerly Unk X-1909, USAF Cemetery, Manila #2) two (2) remains were found, because of bone structure we were able to segregate, and the two remains were assigned Nos. Unk X-3062-A and Unk X-3062-B. No identification tags, burial bottle, personal effects, or other means of identification. Tooth chart impossible due to condition of remains. Skull missing, and no teeth found with remains.

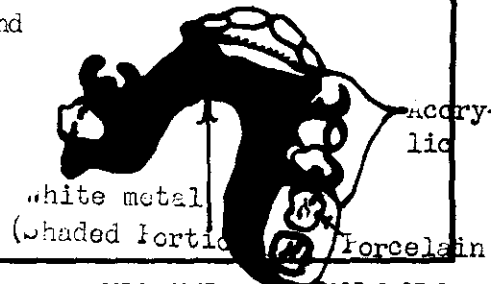

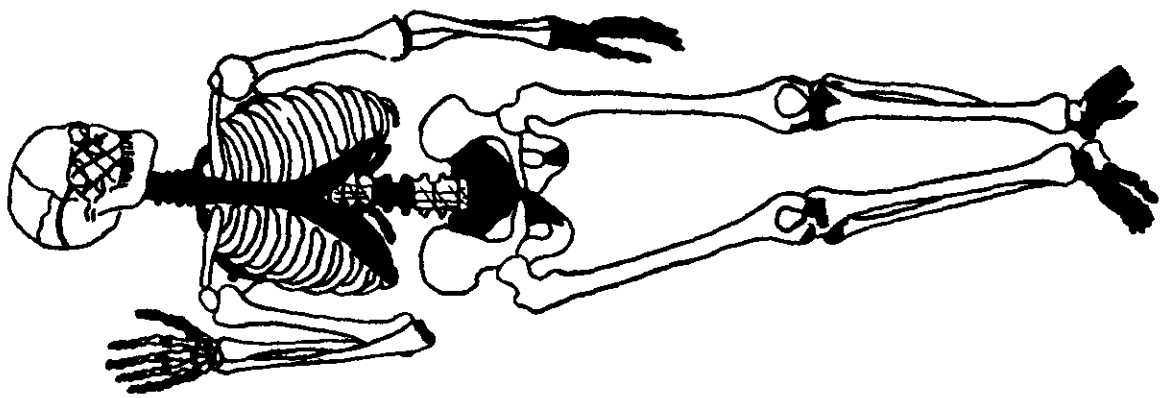
