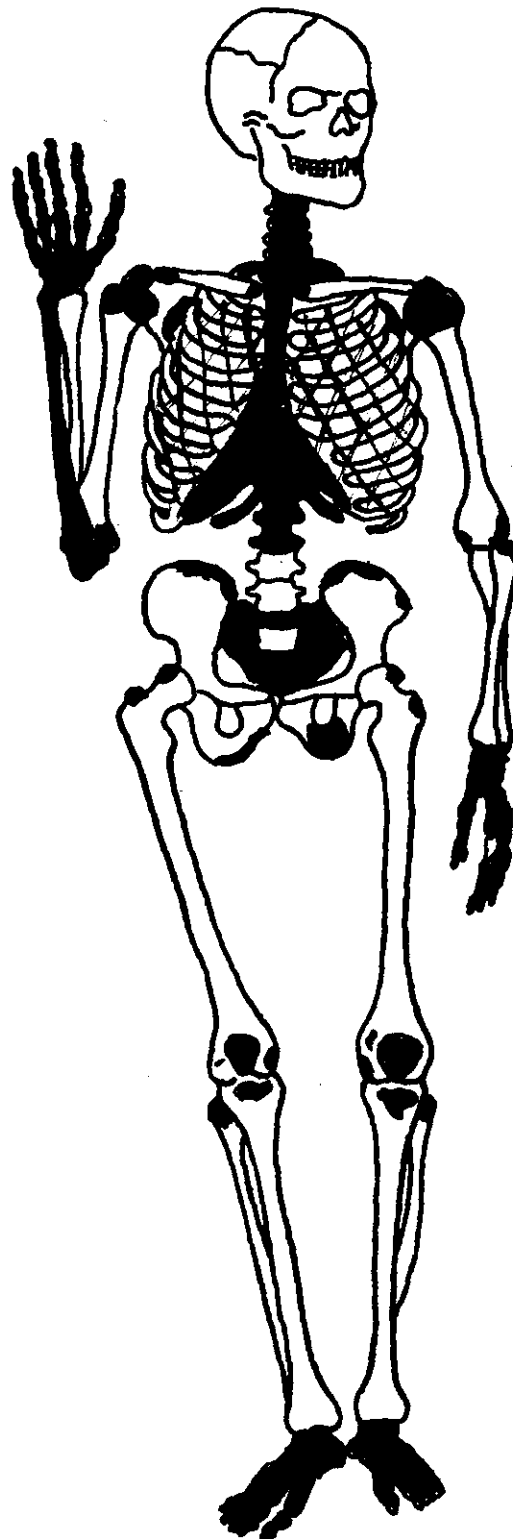

REMARKS:

Body is one of 15 recovered from a reported prisoner of war cemetery at Pasianan, Camarines Norte near Calauag. Originally there were an estimated 60 to 70 Americans buried here. On investigation it was found that 40 Americans were disinterred from this spot on 12 Sept. 1945 by GRS personnel of Base R., now Sub-Base X. All but 1 of the 40 were reburied as unknown. This body as well as other 14 bodies recovered at this time remain unknown and are buried as such. No burial list is available and should there have been one at any previous time it would be useless now as an aid to identification due to the earlier disinterment of the 40 bodies mentioned above.



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
