1. General Condition: Skeletal, no tissue. Long bones in poor condition, complete bones being only left tibia, both humeri and radii. Vertebral column complete. Atlanto-occipital articulation is characterized by a left retro-jugular process very similar to that described for X-689 but with somewhat less displacement laterally to the right. The entire skull and face are complete and show marked asymetry, as though pressure had been on the right frontal and left occipital poles. This is not post-mortem but a developmental feature. There is a large bregmatic interparietal bone. Cranial--post-cranial articulation positive.

2. Co-mingling: No evidence of this.

3. Age: Cranial: Beginning obelic closure, 22-23 years. Pelvic: No evidence available. Clavicle: Medial epiphysis united; not under 26-27 years. Manubrium and blade of sternum united; irregular but infrequent under 25 years. General estimate, 25-26 years.

4. Stature: Rollet, 61 7/8 inches; Krogman, 65 3/4 inches. Based on left tibia, right humerus and an estimate of damaged right femur.

5. Dentition: See Form 569, 1 May 1952. The evidence appears to me to indicate extraction of # 18 and # 19 and backward drift of # 20, # 21 while # 17 has drifted forward. Similarly I suggest that # 14 was extracted and that # 15 and # 16 have drifted forward so that # 15 is now in contact with # 13. This reasoning is based on a comparison of crown patterns and tooth size.

6. Hair Color: No evidence available.

7. Race: White

8. Conclusion and recommendation: The Form 371 data for Lowe is age at death 28, stature 69 1/4 inches, race white. Age estimate here given is not in close agreement and the suture closure is most discordant although I suspect there was retardation in this feature. Stature is also markedly discrepant. The minimum difference being 3 1/2 inches. The limb bones clearly belong to a short statured individual. The dental comparison is favorable on the basis of my interpretation of the condition of the jaws, particularly with the 1937 record. A possibility is that skull and jaws are those of Lowe, remainder of skeleton of another individual, but I can find no convincing evidence that cranial - post-cranial articulation is not clear cut. Certainly the atlas can only fit this skull. In view of the limited evidence, I believe that identification of these remains as those of Lowe is inconclusive.

1. Reference is made to Board Proceedings recommending the following identification:

Unknown X-662, AGFS Mausoleum Manila, as Sgt Lionel L. Lowe,
6 866 137

2. The identification cannot be approved at this time due to the similarity of dental charts for Sgt Lowe and charts accomplished for the remains of Unknown X-658 and X-675, AGFS Mausoleum Manila, recovered from Fort Stotsenburg Cemetery with the remains of Unknowns X-662.

3. It is also considered by this Office that in view of the favorable height and weight estimations and almost identical shoe size recorded for the remains of Unknown X-662, reprocessing of the remains may clarify the present discrepancy between the extractions of teeth I-14, I-15 and I-16 for Sgt Lowe and extractions of teeth I-13, I-14, and I-15 shown on the dental chart for Unknown X-662.

4. The remains of Unknown X-662 may be reconsidered for identification as Sgt Lowe, in the event that the remains of Unknowns X-658 and X-675 are eventually identified.

5. In view of the above facts, Board Proceedings have been disapproved and are returned herewith.

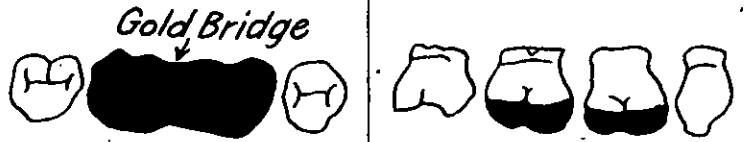
