1. In accordance with the provisions of your letter, file QMGHU 293, GRS (Far East), dated 17 September 1948, subject: Resolution of Cases of Unidentified Deceased, the remains of UNKNOWN X-846, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila P.I., (originally disinterred from Grave 804, Cabanatuan POW Cemetery) were processed by the Central Identification Laboratory and considered "Unidentifiable" by reason of lack of sufficient identifying data.

2. Above mentioned Unknown could not be definitely associated with any of the Cabanatuan POW decedents due to insufficiency of positive identification factors.

3. Forwarded herewith, for your consideration, is the new QMC Form 1044 for the above mentioned Unknown.

4. Also submitted herewith is a list showing the status of the Unknown recovered from afore-mentioned grave.

1. Reference is made to letter this Office dated 26 April 1949, file QMGMT 293, GRS Far East, Subject, same as above, regarding approval of group identification of Unknowns X-845 and X-846, AGRS Mausoleum, Manila, as the remains of Pfc Harry Jerele, 20 600 409, and Pvt Jacob C. Morgan, Jr., 38 011 971.

2. Congressional inquiries have been received concerning Pvt Morgan. The next of kin regretted that individual identification could not be accomplished and pointed out that since his son was of pure Navajo extraction, the distinctive racial features of the American Indian should be present for one of the remains in the group. A photograph of the decedent which was taken shortly before his departure for overseas duty was furnished. As result of these inquiries, the two remains were re-examined at the San Francisco Port of Embarkation by a representative from this Office on 18 October 1949. The examination report indicated the presence of American Indian characteristics. Estimated height was indicated as 5'4". These factors are identical with Army records for Pvt Morgan. The skull of Unknown X-845 was associated with other component parts by articulation. All evidence has been corroborated by an anthropologist, who acted as consultant in this case.

3. Similar examination of the remains of Unknown X-846 indicated a general estimate height which does not compare unfavorably with the recorded height for Pfc Harry Jerele, 20 600 409, however, the dental comparison is negative. Efforts to secure more complete dental records for Pfc Jerele from Army records were made with negative results. Your headquarters will be advised of the disposition of these remains.

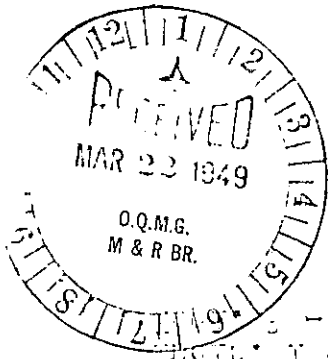

3. The remains of unknown X-368 have since been identified as those of Private George R. Wiegman, 36 152 074.

4. In view of the above, it is requested that unknowns X-366 and X-367 USAF Cemetery Manila #2, P.I., be reprocessed and consideration given to possible identification as the remains of Pfc. Harry Jerele, 20 600 409 and Pvt. Jacob C. Morgan 38 011 974, either individually or as a group. In the event that identification can be established, it is further requested that the findings be submitted to a Field Board of Review and report of proceedings forwarded this Office by air mail.

5. OQMG Forms 371 for Pfc. Jerele and Pvt. Morgan are inclosed as an aid in establishing identity.

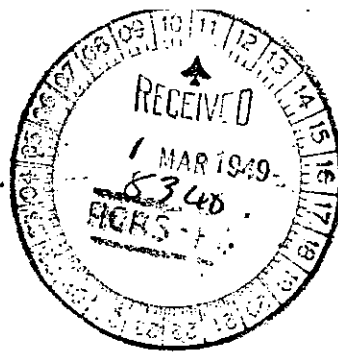

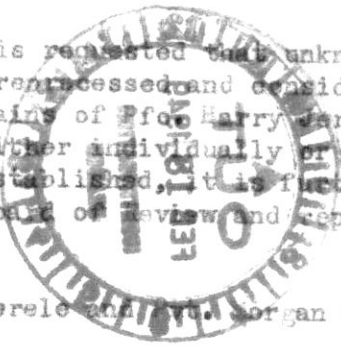

Harry Jerele, 20 600 409 and Pvt. Jacob C. Morgan 38 011 974, either individually or as a group. 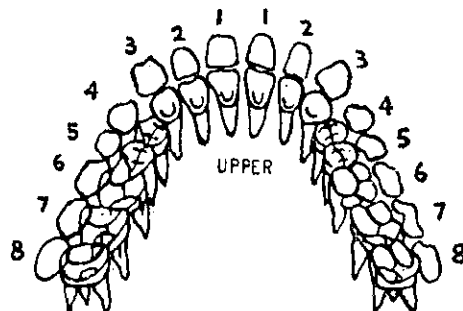
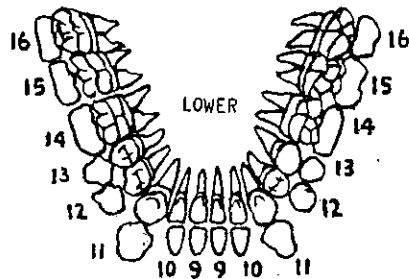
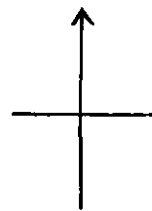


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN
