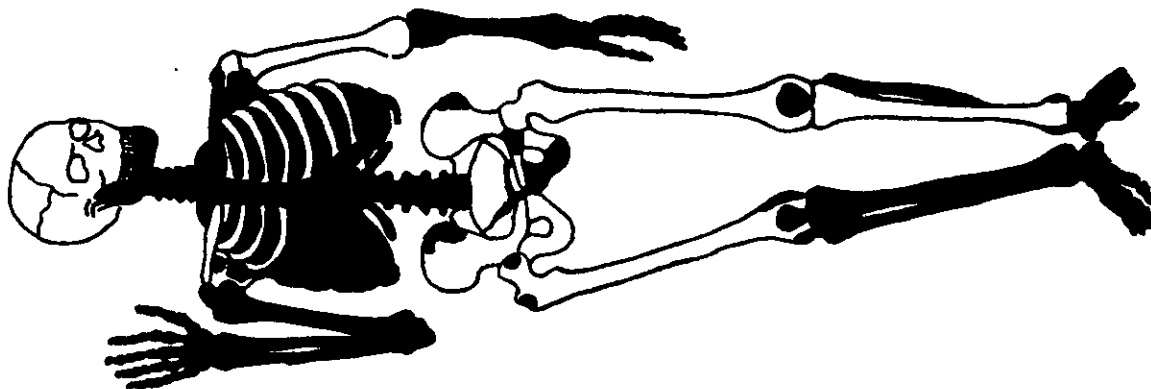



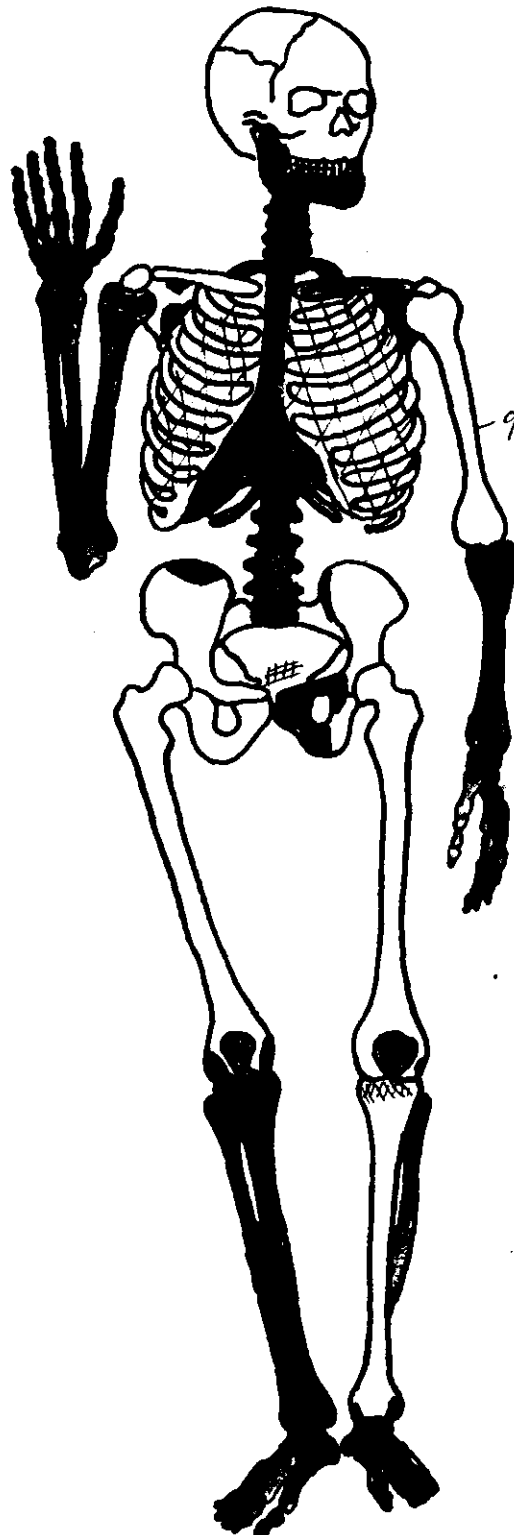

This man accompanied the Investigation Party to the backyard of a house at the left side of the Balanga Road to Pilar, beyond the Balanga bridge, and showed a spot about 20 meters from the road where he allegedly buried an American.

LT NIEVES - Did you bury the body in this spot?
ALMARIO - Yes sir.
N - Was he an American?
A - I am sure he is an American. I found an insignia of an eagle, but I gave the insignia to an American when they arrived in this place recently.
N - Where did you pick up the man?
A - I found him three (3) meters from this spot; he was already dead. Probably he died of hunger.
N - About how old was the man?
A - About 50 or 55 years old.
N - Did you get anything that was on the body of the man?
A - I got only the eagle, which was like silver.
N - Did you find any identification on the body?
A - I also found a suitcase.
N - Where is the suitcase?
A - I threw it away because I was scared of the Japanese; they kill us whenever they see something belonging to Americans in our possession.
N - Where did you throw the suitcase?
A - I do not remember now; it had been a long time ago so I cannot remember.
N - Did you find a dog tag on the man? (showed him what a dog tag is)
A - I found something like that around the neck of the man, but I threw it away. I was scared of the Japanese.
N - Where did you throw that tag?
A - You cannot find it anymore, it had been a long time since.
N - Do you remember the name written on the dog tag?
A - No sir, I do not know how to read and nobody saw the tag. I threw it away in 1942.
N - Can you describe the appearance of the man you buried here?
A - He is tall, about 6 feet, and weighing about 190 lbs.
N - What color was his hair?

Name: Jose Almario - 50 years
Address: Sta. Rosa, Balanga, Bataan
Date: 30 July 1945

ALMARIO - Auburn.
NIEVES - Did he have any gold teeth?
A - No sir. One of his teeth was gone because I hit it
with my spade while I was digging this grave.
N - What color were his eyes?
A - Gray.
N - Was he dressed up when you buried him?
A - Yes sir, he was dressed up in khaki uniform.
N - Where did you find the eagle insignia?
A - I got it from the hat of the man.
N - When did you give the insignia to the American?
A - When they came here recently. He was a private.
N - Do you think the body is still here.
A - I cannot tell, but most probably it is still here
because I covered it when I buried it here.

Mr. Almario also showed the party a water tank about ten meters from the first spot. The place was enclosed with a cement wall about 3 feet square and two feet high. He said 6 men were buried in that place, one of whom was an American.

N - Did you find any dog tag on the bodies you buried here?

A - Yes sir, Gregorio Asiao found a dog tag here.

Mr. Asiao testified that the dog tag was found about 7 meters away from the above-mentioned water tank.
